Have you ever seen the movie *WALL-E*? *WALL-E* is a robot that was built to clean the world after it has been completely polluted by man. People then leave the world to find a better place to live in.

The movie starts with *WALL-E* slowly doing his cleaning job. It seems an impossible job because there is mountains and mountains of garbage (垃圾). The earth is covered in garbage mainly because of many years of mass consumption (大众消费). People simply buy more and more things. Here are some facts about the waste and pollution that we are producing.

- Pollution influences the health of over 100 million people. People who live in places with high levels of air pollution have a 20% higher risk of death from lung (肺) cancer than other people.

- Almost 6.5 billion kilograms of garbage are poured into the sea every year. Most of it is plastic. Over 1 million seabirds are killed by plastic waste each year.

- Each year 4.5 billion liters of untreated polluted water, storm water and industrial waste are poured into the water in the United States.

- Nearly 40% of the lakes in the United States are too polluted for fishing or swimming.

- Over 80% of the garbage could be reused instead.

- About 112,000 computers are thrown out every day in the United States. Over 100 million mobile phones are thrown out every year. Much of this waste ends up in poor countries where they harm the health of the people there.

Take a warm shower before your bedtime





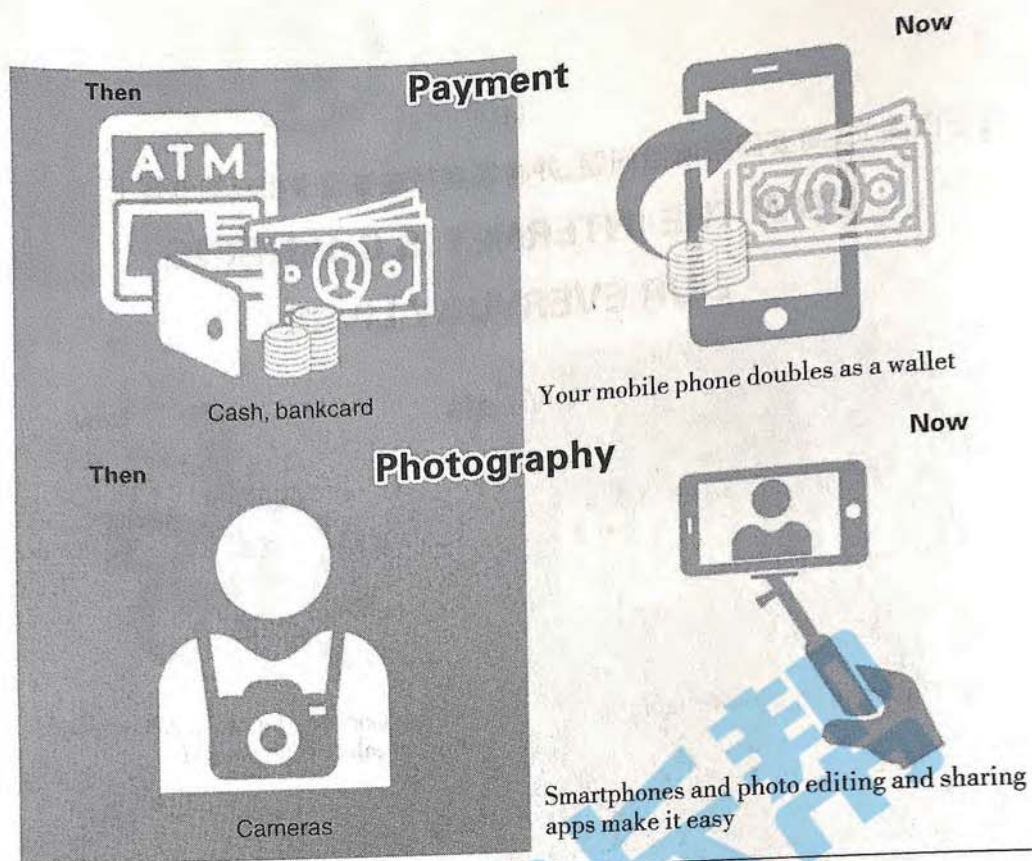
