【解析】line 意为“线”;dream 意为“梦想”;answer 意为“答案”;message 意为“信息”。句意为:“然而没有我父母的支持,那个梦想似乎不可能实现。”故选 B。

【解析】由前句“在一年夏天,我的妹妹 Maggie 要上舞蹈课”可知,此句表示“我马上请求我的父母允许我送她去上课”。故选 A。

【解析】similar 意为“相似的”;funny 意为“有趣的”;good 意为“好的”;strange 意为“奇怪的,陌生的”。根据上文父母不支持他学习舞蹈,而现在可以送妹妹上舞蹈课可知,这是一个很好的学习舞蹈的机会。故选 C。

【解析】句意为:“一天下午当我正在我的房间练习一个新的舞蹈时,Maggie 走了进来。”walk in 意为“走进来”。根据句意可知选 D。
- ( B ) 20. A. drawing B. dancing C. singing D. writing  
【解析】draw 意为“绘画”;dance 意为“跳舞”;sing 意为“唱歌”;write 意为“写”。根据上文“...I was practicing a new dance in my room...”可知,“我停止了跳舞”。结合语境可知选 B。
- ( A ) 21. A. but B. or C. so D. if  
【解析】句意为:“在我的学校将有一个舞蹈表演节目,但是男孩们认为我慢,他们没有人想做我的舞伴。”but 意为“但是”,转折连词;or 意为“或者,否则”,并列连词;so 意为“所以”,因果连词;if 意为“如果”,引导条件状语从句。结合句意可知选 A。

【解析】need 意为“需要”;must 意为“必须”;could 意为“能,可以”;should 意为“应该”。根据上文妹妹的困难可知,此处是表示请求,故选 C。
- ( D ) 23. A. sad B. lazy C. sorry D. wrong  
【解析】sad 意为“悲伤的”;lazy 意为“懒惰的”;sorry 意为“遗憾的”;wrong 意为“错误的”。根据前句对妹妹的鼓励可知,让“我们”向那些人证明他们错了。故选 D。
- ( D ) 24. A. chatted B. rested C. slept D. practiced  
【解析】chat 意为“聊天”;rest 意为“休息”;sleep 意为“睡觉”;practice 意为“练习”。句意为:“在接下来的几个月里,我们每天晚上都背着父母练习。”故选 D。
- ( B ) 25. A. first B. soon C. never D. seldom  
【解析】first 意为“第一,首先”;soon 意为“很快”;never 意为“从不”;seldom 意为“很少”。句意为:“我度过了一段极好的时光,并且 Maggie 也提高了许多。”故选 B。
- ( C ) 26. A. shy B. bored C. nervous D. angry  
【解析】shy 意为“害羞的”;bored 意为“无聊的”;nervous 意为“紧张的”;angry 意为“生气的”。根据上文父母不支持“我”跳舞可知,此处表示“当听说我的父母要来看节目时我变得非常紧张”。故选 C。
- ( A ) 27. A. music B. lesson C. meeting D. party  
【解析】music 意为“音乐”;lesson 意为“课”;meeting 意为“会议”;party 意为“聚会”。句意为:“当音乐响起来,我深呼吸,让自己镇定下来。”故选 A。

- ( C ) 28. A. arrived B. finished C. succeeded D. regretted  
【解析】arrive 意为“到达”;finish 意为“结束”;succeed 意为“成功”;regret 意为“后悔”。句意为:“从人群传来的欢呼中我确信我们成功了。”故选 C。
- ( A ) 29. A. father B. mother C. sister D. classmate  
【解析】根据后文中的人称代词 he,可知是男性,根据对作者的称呼是 son 可知是“父亲”,故选 A。
- ( D ) 30. A. took away B. paid for C. fell into D. belonged to  
【解析】take away 意为“带走”;pay for 意为“为……付款”;fall into 意为“跌入”;belong to 意为“属于”。句意为:“虽然我很难承认这件事,但是看起来真的像属于这个舞台。”故选 D。

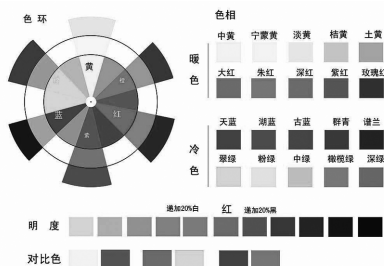


Different people like different foods. Some people do not like meat. They eat most kinds of fruits and vegetables. Some people do not like potatoes or bread. They prefer rice or corn.

“No,” answered Tommy. “They are my brother's.”

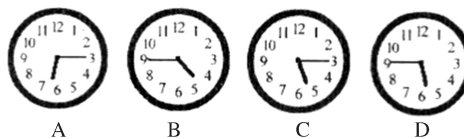
“But Tommy, you should show your own hobby here, not somebody else's!”
