Does your Mom or Dad have to wake you up every morning? If you often have trouble waking up on your own, you may not get enough sleep.

Why is sleep so important? Sleep gives your body a chance to rest. Your muscles (肌肉) relax. Your heart slows down. Your body takes a break and builds energy for the next day. Sleep also helps your body heal (治愈) when you're sick. It helps your body grow. And sleep is very important for your brain, too.

Your brain is the command (指挥) center for your body. All day long your brain is hard at work. It takes in all kinds of information. It uses that information to tell your body how to respond. For example, on a hot day you might feel very warm. Your brain sends signals to your skin to make you **sweat** so that you'll cool off. Your brain stores facts like your telephone number. Every moment of every day, your brain is busy.

When you go to sleep, your brain does not "turn off". But at least it gets a break from taking in information. Some scientists think your brain does an important job when you sleep. They think it sorts the information it's taken in during the day. Some people believe that your brain can solve problems while you sleep.

Your brain also spends some time dreaming every night. Scientists do not really understand dreams. They think that dreams might help your brain make sense of things that happen during the day. Dreams can be silly or scary, happy or sad. Often, they don't seem to mean anything.

What happens if you don't get enough sleep? For one thing, you'll get angry more easily. Missing sleep can make you stupid, too. You are more likely to drop things or trip over your own feet. You won't be able to think well, either. Even simple tasks are difficult for a tired brain. If you don't get enough sleep, you won't be at your best.

If you want to have a good day, start with a good night's sleep.

C

Have you ever seen a car without a driver? It sounds crazy, but these computer-driven driver-less cars have appeared on the roads in Shenzhen. Companies like Google and Tesla have been designing and testing these cars, and the technology is there.

So how? The cars have sensors(感应器) all around which can find other cars and objects in the road. Road signs are read by cameras, and satellite navigation systems(卫星导航系统) are used, so the car knows how to get where you want to go. All you have to do is type in the address! Finally, a central computer system takes in all the information that it receives from the sensors and cameras and works out when to speed up, stop and turn.

Sound like your idea of heaven. Sitting back, looking out of the windows and even watching a film or reading a book while “driving” would be possible with this new technology. You wouldn’t have to worry about remembering directions to where you’re going. In addition, computers would also drive more safely than people—they would obey the rules and have quicker action times when in dangerous situations.

However, there are many drawbacks of driver-less cars. Computers would have difficulties making ethical(道德的) decisions: if a child ran into the road, would the computer choose to hit the child or turn suddenly and **potentially** kill the car’s passengers? Moreover, I personally find driving fun—I’d miss never driving a car myself. There would also be many other decisions to be made—should children, or drunk people be allowed in a driver-less car by themselves? Or would there need to be a person with a driving license in the car at all times?

I’m not certain I’d want a driver-less car—but it’s only a matter of time before they’ll become more affordable and popular on our roads.
