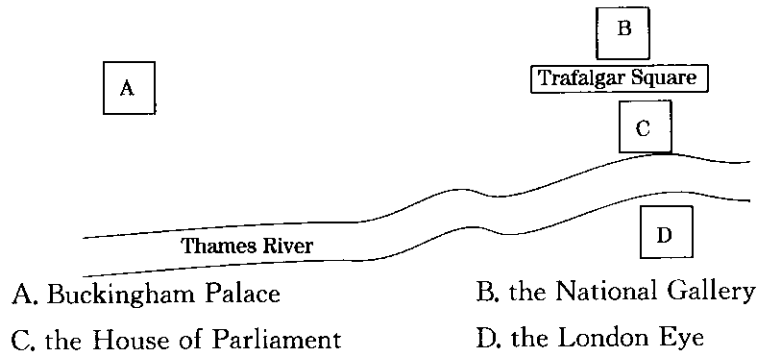

It's exciting to hear a good and easy song. But you may find that for a few hours, even a whole day, you just can't get it out of your head.

This is called an "earworm" (耳朵虫). It has been studied before. But people don't understand why it appears, and how to get rid of it.

Now researchers say they have an answer: the secret to getting rid of these "earworms" may be to simply chew gum (嚼口香糖).

Scientists at the University of Reading, UK, did a study with 98 volunteers. They listened to the simple songs Play Hard by David Guetta and Payphone by Maroon 5. For three minutes after listening to the songs, the volunteers were asked to hit the table whenever the song came back into their head. During the three—minute period, the volunteers chewed gum, moved their fingers on the table, or did neither.

Volunteers reported that while chewing gum, they thought of the songs less often than when they weren't chewing gum, or when they were told to move their fingers.

How does it work?

"Brain (大脑) areas about hearing, remembering and recalling music include not only the listening area but also about speech area," said Phil Beaman, the lead scientist. "By making these areas active in chewing the gum, they were hardly able to make an
