

Recently, a designer in Hong Kong has invented a special book that can transform* into a piece of furniture*. The special book is called Bookniture. It can be unfolded* to become a chair or a small table. People can either carry it around for a portable* chair or can store it in their homes to use as extra furniture.

The book was designed by Mike Mak. He came up with the idea after never having enough seats for his friends in his home in Hong Kong.

"I love having friends at my place, but I have never had enough seats for everyone—we would always sit on the floor. I really want a seat that doesn't take up any floor space when I don't need it. One day, the empty space appeared on my bookcase. Then came the new idea—Bookniture, furniture hidden in a book," said the 30-year-old designer.

Made from fully-recyclable kraft paper*, the book measures 33 cm by 18 cm. It expands* to 14 times bigger once it's opened, and can support up to 1,000 kg of weight. It comes in two colors, brown and black, and can be bought for between £55 and £57.

"Donna had to stay with the baby," he said, "but we want to help you. I remember when my father died, it took me hours to clean our shoes for the funeral*. Give me all your shoes."

I gathered all our dirty shoes to the kitchen. Peter got to work right away. Watching him devoting himself to one task helped me pull my own thoughts into order. I told myself to wash clothes first. Then, Larry and I bathed the children and put them to bed. One job after another.

When we returned to clear the dishes, Peter had left. All our shoes stood in a line against the wall, clean, shining. I couldn't help crying. Early next morning, we left for the airport with all the jobs done.

Now whenever I hear of a friend who's lost a loved one, I no longer call with the polite offer, "If there's anything I can do..." AlphaGo is a computer program to play Go. It's an AI program developed by Google DeepMind in London. In the early days, AlphaGo could not win a single game, even against amateur* players.



However, in recent years the AI program has developed fast. It is learning all the time. In October 2015, AlphaGo beat European Go champion Fan Hui, a 2-dan professional player. The score was 5 to 0. Although Fan Hui is not a world-class player, the result of the game was greatly surprising. This was the first time that a computer Go program had beaten a professional human player without handicaps*.

In March 2016, Man vs. Machines Go was held in Seoul, South Korea. In the match, AlphaGo played against Lee Se-dol, a 9-dan professional player from South Korea. In the end, AlphaGo beat the world-class player Lee Se-dol. During the five-game match, AlphaGo won four matches, and only lost the fourth game. It has become the first computer program to beat a top-level Go player without handicaps.

Now AlphaGo was the second in Go Rating of the world. DeepMind developers hoped Ke Jie would take on AlphaGo in the next Man vs. Machines Go. Ke Jie, an eighteen-year-old boy from China, was the No.1 in Go Rating of the world. He believed he was the one to beat AlphaGo, but he failed in the match between AlphaGo and him. He thinks AlphaGo is the best player in the world which can teach itself and develops better and better.
