It is a fact that people die every moment of every day. However, the deaths of those who have done great work can be especially shocking and heartbreaking.

On Jan 26, Kobe Bryant, one of the most famous NBA players in history, died in a terrible accident. He was 41 years old when a helicopter he was riding in crashed (坠毁), killing him and eight others, including his 13-year-old daughter Gianna Bryant.

Following Bryant's death, many people have paid honor to the late basketball superstar - not just for his achievements on the court, but also for his personality and the inspiration he has given to us. In the basketball world, Bryant ranks among the top players of all time. He was fast, skillful and aggressive, which earned him the nickname "Black Mamba", one of the most deadly snakes in the world. That's why his competitive philosophy (哲学) is known as the "Mamba Mentality".

"Mamba mentality is you're going, you're competing, you're not worried about the end result," Bryant said. "It's all about focusing on the process and trusting in the hard work when it matters most."

Off the court, Bryant was known as a successful businessman, an Oscar-winning filmmaker, and a proud father of four daughters.

The fact that Bryant is no longer with us is sad. We'll never see him give another interview or play in another game. But the work he has done will keep inspiring us years after his death.

What inspires you to work hard? Having your own goals is important. Good sleep also helps. But as it turns out, having a plant on your desk can improve your work as well.

Mike Robinson, an engineer from Canada, owns his own small company. One day, his wife suggested picking out some plants and putting them on his workers' desks. Robinson doubted the idea at first. What good would plants do? He thought they might even be distracting (让人分心的). But he decided to try out the idea.

First, Robinson bought 20 plants for his workers. He asked each worker to make a small sign that said "My name is \_\_\_\_\_" and write their own name on the sign. Then, they put the sign on the plant they chose and took it back to their desk. To his surprise, Robinson found that his workers were working much harder and getting along much better than before.

(C)

You might like to listen to music while studying. What kind of music is your favorite? An experiment done with British workers found that listening to classical music at work can improve one's efficiency (效率) by 15 percent.

A previous survey of 2,000 British workers found that half of them regularly listen to music on the job. Some of their bosses encourage them to do so, while others are against it, believing it hurts work performance. Becky Spelman from Britain did an experiment to find out if background music hurts or improves efficiency.

In the experiment, four office workers were asked to copy two 600-word sets of song lyrics. The group worked on the first set with no music playing and worked on the second set with classical music playing in the background.

It took them an average (平均) time of 20 minutes and 59 seconds to finish the first set. The average time for the second set was 17 minutes and 42 seconds. The difference was three minutes and 17 seconds, or 15 percent.

Classical music can work as a kind of white noise, according to Spelman. White noise is a mixture of sounds with different frequencies (频率). It can help people stay focused.

In fact, as long as the music has a calm and regular beat, it can help us slow our heart rate and stay calm. This makes it easier for us to focus on what we're doing, Spelman said.

When using a computer, first sit in your chair and reach out your arm. Your hand should rest comfortably on the screen, as if you're high-fiving the screen. 89 In this way, you can read what's on the screen easily and correctly.

When you are using a mobile phone, keep it at least 30 cm from your eyes and just below eye level. Besides, you need to be more careful when you use it outside. 90. It is very harmful to your eyes.

Remember to take a 20-20-20 break: every 20 minutes, take a 20-second break and look at something 20 feet (about 6 meters) away.
