The Mate X is both a phone and a tablet(平板电脑). When folded, it works as a phone. When unfolded, it is a tablet. The phone is very thin. 	<p>Parkour</p> <p>Parkour is a special sport that makes it possible for people to get around cities in a creative way. People jump, climb, roll and crawl to move across, through, over and under obstacles so that they find their way as fast as they can.</p>
	<p>Surfing</p> <p>In this sport, surfers stand on top of a surfboard and ride across big waves (波浪). Surfers need to have excellent balance (平衡) and be able to swim in rough waters if they fall off their board. Surfers also learn how to do some special acts such as backflip (后翻) and rotations (旋转).</p>
