

Most teenagers feel sad or afraid when their parents argue. They might think their parents don't love each other any more and that their arguments will lead to a divorce(导致离婚). In fact, occasional (偶尔的) arguments are a sign of a healthy relationship.

One important thing for teenagers: If you ever see the arguments between your parents turn violent (暴力), don't be afraid to bring it up with your teacher or another adult you trust. They will know what to do.
