“Is your math taught by a PE teacher?”

We've all heard this sentence, which means someone's math is very bad. But is there any possibility that PE teachers are misunderstood?

PE, short for physical education, is a compulsory subject across schools of all levels. For a long time, there was a stereotype about PE teachers as physically fit but academically ignorant. And this is what gave rise to the sentence above.

In Chinese schools, Chinese, English and math teachers are usually head teachers for classes. Sometimes, physics, chemistry, history or politics teachers are doing this job, too.

However, a young female PE teacher in a secondary school in Hangzhou was quite willing to be the head teacher and has been doing the job for over two months, in arguments, of course.

Parents of the students in her class had a heated debate over this matter when the news first came out. Some feared that the PE teacher, Ms. Su, may not be familiar with most of the main subjects, which might negatively influence students' academic performance. This is because, traditionally, students in a certain class are influenced most by their head teacher. Others expressed their support for Ms. Su, saying that with less pressure in teaching, a head teacher from PE would focus more on the management of the class, and more patient and caring with students.

The news soon became a hot topic on Sina Weibo, with 270 million views and 22,000 discussions by Thursday afternoon. Netizens shared their stories and views on this topic.

“Our head teacher in high school was a PE teacher, but he was stricter with us than any of the other head teachers. Our average score in every test was higher than that in other classes...”

“I once had a head teacher from music who was very energetic and popular among the kids. We liked him very much and would follow his advice...”

“As a parent, it may feel not so good if a kid is in a class with a head teacher from PE, because it seems that the school does not pay much attention to this class.”

The women’s national volleyball team has been the 56 of the Chinese people since China first won the championship in 1981. It beat Serbia on September 28, right before the National Day holiday, holding its World Cup crown with a 57 of 11 wins.

It was China’s 10th title in world major volleyball events, 58 the World Cup, the World Championships and the Olympic Games.
