Huge explosion hits city of Beirut

On Aug 4, there was a huge explosion in Beirut, the capital of Lebanon. The explosion sent a mushroom cloud into the air and the effect were felt over 240 km away, the BBC reported.



The explosion did a lot of damage to the city. Roofs fell in, buildings were damaged, windows were broken, and cars were flipped over. By Aug 12, the explosion had killed 171 people. Nearly 6000 people were injured and around 300,000 became homeless, the New York Post reported.

The explosion was caused by 2,750 tons of ammonium nitrate(硝酸铵) stored at a port. The chemical is mainly used as a fertilizer(肥料). But it can also be used to make explosive.

B

Being honest is important. To build trust in society, individuals and companies in China who behave dishonestly will be punished.

Over the past month, 38 Chinese government authorities have signed more than 30 memorandums (备忘录) with each other. They promised to share information about dishonest individuals and companies and punish them accordingly.

For example, people who avoid paying their taxes or disrupt public order will be put on a government blacklist. They will be prevented from buying certain items and services for 180 days, including plane and train tickets. LeEco founder Jia Yueting, who failed to repay millions of yuan worth of debt, is on the blacklist. Sun He, a man who stole a woman's seat on a train on Aug 21 and refused to move, is on the list as well.

Those with severely dishonest behavior in the field of intellectual property right(知识产权) will also be punished. They will not be allowed to book high-end hotels or buy houses in China.

China is setting up a national social credit system that is expected to be fully carried out by the end of 2020. By then, every permanent resident(永久居民), company and organization in China will have to register(注册) for an official credit scores. Credit scores have already been widely used in some areas. For instance, banks will check your score if you apply for a credit card. If you don't pay your bills on time, your score drops and you cannot receive loans from banks for a certain period.
