It is said that eyes are the windows of our soul. Therefore, in order to have healthy eyes, we have to protect them properly. Our eyes need good care every day.

First, we have to pay more attention to our diet. Have more fresh fruits, vegetables, fish, eggs and milk. They are good for our eyes. Besides, a regular amount of vitamin A and B2 should also be taken.

Second, we must have a good sleep. It relaxes the eye muscles and gives them the rest they need. Sleep can help the body repair its tired tissue. Usually, we must sleep for at least eight hours

every day. Lack of sleep can bring us dark circles around the eyes.

Too much reading, writing, watching television or working on the computer can also make our eyes tired, so a good rest is needed.
