When I was in the middle school, I seldom raised my hands to answer questions in class. And I found most of my classmates were just like me. When the teacher asked a question, I always lowered(降低) my head because I was afraid that the teacher saw me.

One day, in a foreign language class, Mr. Black gave us a lesson. He wanted us to be active in class, so he asked us some questions, but no one answered. "At the beginning of the class, let me tell you a story," he said.

"When I came to the United States to study, the university often invited famous people to make speeches. Before the beginning of every speech, I found an interesting thing. In the past, working people in Britain only had holidays on religious(宗教的) days: Sundays, Christmas and Easter. Now most people have about four weeks of holiday time every year including public holidays.

When?

Most British workers take a two-week holiday in July or August. Schoolchildren are on holiday from the end of July to the start of September. Taking a second holiday break in winter or spring is also becoming more popular in the UK.

Where?

The most popular holiday destinations(目的地) for the British include Spain, France and the US. Lots of people buy a package holiday(包价旅游) that includes flights and a hotel or an apartment. Cheap flights mean that many British people can spend two weeks a year vacationing abroad. Flights and package holidays are much cheaper during school terms and the British government is worried that some young people are skipping school(逃课) to go on holiday. Parents who take their child on vacation during term time must now pay a **fine**.

Independent holidays

Some teenagers want to spend their holidays doing something without their family. A language exchange is one way to become more independent and improve one's language skills. A British teenager might spend a week or two in a foreign country, staying with a family who has a son or daughter of the same age and practicing the local language. Later, the foreign teenager might visit the UK to practice their English with a British family.

Finally, the Ghost of Christmas Yet to Come takes him to the future. He sees that he is dead but nobody cares. He is so scared that he wakes up in his bed and finds out it is only the next morning—Christmas Day!

He decides to change his life and promises to be a better person. He now treats everyone kindly and warmly(热情地). And that is the true spirit of Christmas!

In recent years, with more and more cars on the road, flying robots are used to deliver(递送) mails. Flying robots can carry mails to people's houses without having to worry about heavy traffic. But they will spend too much time in returning. A research center is trying to improve its flying robots with the help of homing pigeons(信鸽).

Homing pigeons are pigeons that are specially trained to fly home from somewhere else. In tests, researchers found that homing pigeons were more efficient(高效的) than flying robots at returning to their home. So the research center is trying to use a flying robot, together with a homing pigeon, to deliver mails. After the robot finishes its tasks, it can follow the pigeon back in the shortest possible time.

Although the cost(成本) of training pigeons is very high, the research center says that it can save time. And the time it saves will make up for(弥补) the cost.
