C

The Chinese paddlefish was part of an ancient group of fish that had lived since around 200 million years ago.

This world's largest freshwater fish could reach up to be unbelievable 7 meters long and weigh as much as nearly half a ton. It had a long, silver-colored body and a very large mouth. With weakly developed eyes, the fish fed with its mouth open and used its long, sword-like nose to sense its food. And its **rarity** also made this fish become the "Panda of the Yangtze River".

The Chinese paddlefish mainly lived in the large rivers, but sometimes travelled into large lakes. They were strong swimmers. But wherever they went, they usually lived alone and took up the lower part of the water. Unlike the American paddlefish, the Chinese paddlefish was mainly feeding on small to medium-sized fishes in rivers or lakes.

Although the Chinese paddlefish spent part of their life in the lower section of the Yangtze, they travelled up to lay eggs, which happened in spring, from mid-March to early April. The grown fish can lay a large number of eggs. There used to be tons of Chinese paddlefish in the Yangtze River.

After the 1970s, the number of the paddlefish became smaller and smaller. There have only been two alive fish recorded. The Chinese paddlefish was reported to be extinct(灭绝的) in a study by Chinese scientists in late 2019. In fact, it hasn't been seen since 2003 and it's thought that it died out sometime between 2005 and 2010.

Comfort Zone is a state of mind where there is the least stress. However, stepping into the learning zone can help to bring out the best in us. Here are the reasons.

▲ Challenging yourself can help you do at your best.

Stepping out of one's comfort zone is important to personal development. How can we expect to make ourselves better if we only stick to habit and routine(日常)? We should try something we might not succeed at.

▲ Taking risks is what helps us grow.

As children, we were natural risk-takers. But as we get older and learn to fear failure(失败), we start trying fewer new things. We pay a heavy price for our fear of failure. There is no learning without some difficulty.

▲ Facing new challenges can help us grow better.

Our comfort zones seem to become smaller as we get older, but if we can keep expanding(扩展) them, we'll open ourselves up to a greater world as we grow. As we step into the learning zone, we will get more comfortable with the skills gradually and we'll start to move into the comfort zone. A study found that learning new life skills can help our brain stay sharp(敏锐

的) as we get older.

However, don't push yourself too far. Have you heard of "Yerkes-Dodson Law"? It means performance increases as stress grows, but only up to a point. If the level of stress becomes too high, performance will go down. When stress becomes too great for us to deal with, we step into the dangerous zone.

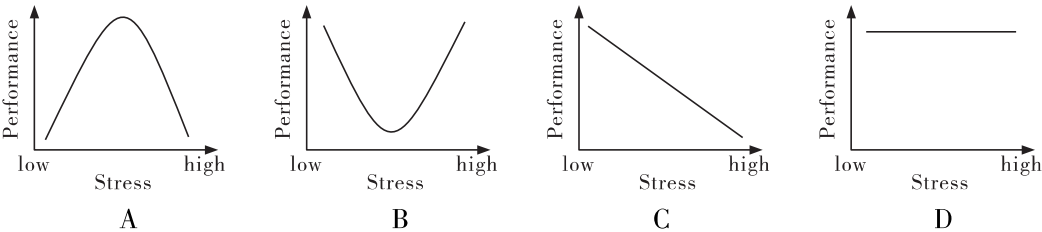

Keeping Safe in School During a Fire

Though you may not think you'll ever happen to meet a fire, it's better to be prepared to avoid panicking(恐慌). To increase your chances of survival, just follow these tips.

♣ If you see a fire or smell smoke, don't wait. All the rooms in the school have got fire alarm switches(开关). Use something hard like a shoe, to break glass and start the fire alarm. Don't stop to get your course books and notes. Leave your bag in the room.

♣ If you don't see smoke at the door, open it slowly and pass through it after making sure the door feels cool. If there is a fire preventing you from getting out of the room, close the door.

♣ Protect yourself from smoke inhalation(吸入). Get low to the floor and crawl on your hands and knees to avoid the smoke. Cover your nose and mouth if you have to walk by or through a heavily smoke-filled room.

♣ Don't run! Walk quickly to the parking area. Remember to follow the directions on the fire escape map.

♣ Don't go home! Wait for your teacher to call your name and be sure that you are safe. Be careful. Don't go back into the school buildings unless a teacher has told you that it is safe.

Fire Emergency Guidance in Sunny School

- ① Break the glass with something hard, and start the fire alarm.
- ② Make sure the door is cool and with no 44 in, then open it slowly.

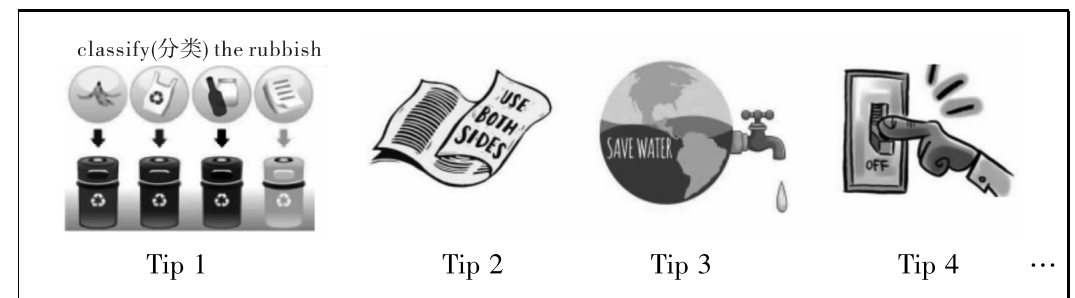
