During the Ming and Qing Dynasties, emperors were dressed in yellow. Official flags were yellow. In the Forbidden City of Beijing, you can see a sea of yellow glazed tiles.

Green is the color of wealth, hope and growth. Green also stands for the pure and clean.

Buildings, banks and restaurants are often painted in green. Packaging for milk or produce is often in green to tell people that the product is contamination-free.
