I could stay in my bed until late afternoon. I could wake up when I felt like it and enjoy my coffee as I worked on my book. At first it was like beginning in heaven.

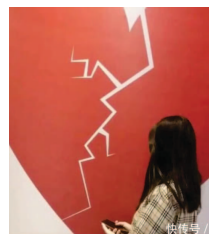

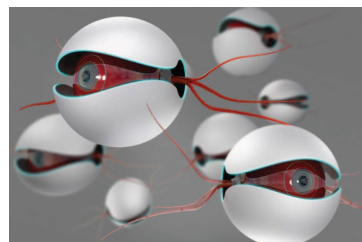
