* If you're not into crowds and are satisfied with just hearing the music, there is plenty of space on the grass outside of the Central Park SummerStage area.

A few days later, I saw Ronny reading the book when I went back to the school. His teacher said, "He hasn't put that book down. That's the first book he's ever owned."

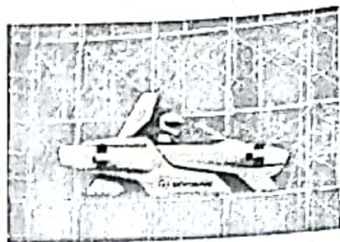

Movies about the future often show people flying around in flying cars. Lately, a Japanese company called SkyDrive has made it come true. Its new flying car, the SD-03, flew in circles in a special area for four minutes, staying about 1 to 2 meters off the ground.



What made this test flight (飞行) special was that a pilot was on board. Tomohiro Fukuzawa, who leads SkyDrive, said, "Of the world's more than 100 flying car projects, only a handful has succeeded with a person in the flying car."

Many groups around the world are working to develop flying cars. They hope that flying cars will be useful for short trips in cities in the future. But there are many challenges in the way.

Safety is the main problem. If flying cars have an accident, it could hurt not just the people in the car, but people on the ground.

With lots of cars flying around, new systems (系统) will be needed to help control traffic in the air in real time.

Flying cars also use a lot of energy. Still, since most flying cars being developed are electric, they should make less pollution.

Finally, flying cars are very expensive. When it's ready, SkyDrive's flying car is expected to sell for between \$300,000 and \$500,000.

But people who believe in flying cars point out that many of the big problems will be solved with time.

Mr. Fukuzawa wants SkyDrive to be able to fly two passengers on trips of up to 5 kilometers by 2023. By 2050, he hopes people will be able to fly anywhere inside Tokyo in just 10 minutes. "I think flying cars will become common in the near future," he says.

My neighbor Mrs. Gargan first told me about it. "Have you seen the tree?" she asked while I was sitting in the backyard, watching the October sunset. "The one down at the corner," she explained. "It's a beautiful tree—all kinds of colors. You should see it." I told her I would, but I soon forgot about the tree.

Three days later, I was running down the street when some bright orange caught my eyes. For a moment, I thought someone's house had caught fire. Then I remembered the tree.

I went near the tree to look at it closely. There was nothing special about the shape of the tree. It was a medium-sized maple (枫树). But Mrs. Gargan was right about its colors. Like the mess of an artist's palette (调色板), the tree had a bright red on its lower branches and burned with yellows and oranges in its center, and deep red at its top. Through these colors were light-green or deep-green leaves. Going closer, I saw fallen leaves lying like a red carpet (地毯) on the ground.

When I was amazed at this beauty, I thought of what Ralph Waldo Emerson said about the stars. "If the constellations (星座) appeared only once in a thousand years, imagine what an exciting event it would be. But because they're up there every night, we only give them a look." I felt the same way about the tree. Because its beauty will last only a week, it should be especially precious to us. And I had almost missed it.

Once when someone noticed a wonderful show of northern lights in the sky, he rang a church bell to tell the people. That's what I felt like doing about the tree. When I walked home, I asked each neighbor I met the same simple but important question Mrs. Gargan had asked me, "Have you seen the tree?"

• You learn to understand spoken language. 74 So the actors talk fast, just like native speakers talk in real life.

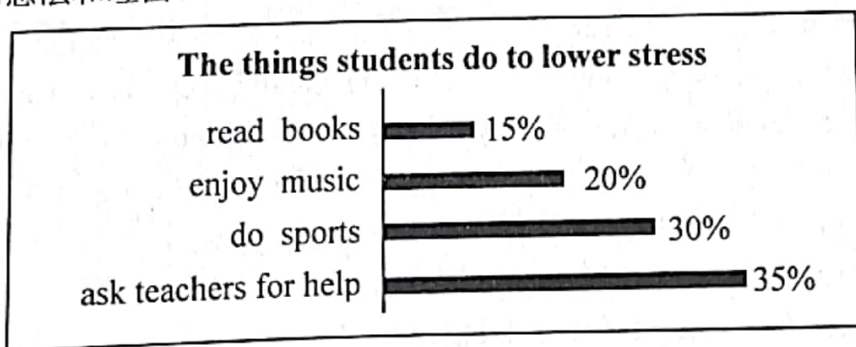
