
You might also want to consider using the Short-Term Parking Lot. There, you can explore our shops and restaurants before meeting your passengers.

Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs was America's first feature-length (长篇) cartoon. It was first put on in 1937. The year turned out to be a historical moment in the history of American movies.

Before 1937, short cartoons took up most of American movie market. Short subjects, even successful ones like *Three Little Pigs*, however, didn't bring in much money. In 1934, Walt Disney had the idea that he would make the Grimm brothers' well-known story *Snow White* into a feature-length cartoon. When he first talked about his plans to his colleagues, although they thought highly of Disney's idea, they were nervous that the moviegoers could not sit through a feature-length cartoon. Even his wife, Lillian, tried to discourage him from continuing the cartoon. But Disney believed in his idea. He spent hours telling them about the story, acting out each part. His performance was so powerful that he finally had everyone believing in it.

In 1938, the movie became a box-office success, making more money than any other one at that time. In 1939, *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* won Disney an Oscar for having been loved by millions and pioneered a great new entertainment field. The cartoon was generally considered to be Walt Disney's greatest achievement. It was not the Prince's kiss that brought her to life, but Walt Disney.

Northern California's wine country attracts millions of tourists in harvest season each year. But harvest season now comes at the same time as another yearly event: wildfires.

In three of the past four years, wildfires have destroyed parts of the world-famous area. Last month, firefighters were still fighting against a fire in Napa Valley because of hot, dry, windy weather.

Still, most of the countryside, winemaking factories and tasting rooms that bring wine lovers to Northern California have escaped harm. But the frightening mental pictures of the area in flames stop people from making long-term plans to vacation here. Visitors don't want to take a risk and are rethinking their plans to visit the area. So locals who depend on the tourist economy (经济) have been rethinking their marketing plans.

Knowing the fall season has become an undependable time to visit, tourism officials have launched campaigns (活动) to get visitors from far away to plan for winter or spring. During those seasons, wild flowers are everywhere and the area is less busy. Online, an organization is marketing the Cabernet wine season, which runs from November to April. And for fall, Sonoma County Tourism wants to attract visitors nearby because they can make last-minute plans.

“Napa remains beautiful, the wineries (酒庄) are open again and people are here,” said the manager of a local hotel. “The best way people can support us is to come visit, drink the wine and have a lovely time. Just be sure to call ahead.”

A Long March 5 rocket took off from the Wenchang Spacecraft Launch Site in Southern China's Hainan Province on November 24, 2020, carrying Chang'e 5 lunar probe on its mission to return lunar samples to Earth.

The carrier Long March 5 rocket is currently the most powerful member of the famous rocket family Long March. The large family is organized into several series: Long March 1, Long March 2, Long March 3, Long March 4, Long March 5 and so on. Each series includes several variants (型号). As an example, below is a chart showing the organization of the Long March 2 series.

The Long March 2F is a remarkable member of the rocket family. It took China's first astronaut Yang Liwei into space in 2003, making China the third nation to independently send humans into space, 42 years after the Soviets (苏联人) and Americans. Another notable member is the Long March 1. China used it to launch its first satellite, Dong Fang Hong 1, into Low Earth orbit (轨道) in 1970, becoming the world's fifth country to launch a satellite into Earth's orbit.

Over a dozen types of Long March rockets have been developed and put into use since 1970, and planning and testing are underway to develop new ones. The Long March rockets are used for a series of key space projects, including BeiDou Navigation Satellite System and the Gaofen Earth observation project as well as lunar exploration and manned space program. Together, these rockets make it possible to serve this world and explore other ones. Someday they may even send humans to Mars.



After nine years since its last edition (版本), the 12th edition of *Xinhua Dictionary* comes out. It has added new words and expressions shaped by the Internet and social 81 ['prəʊgres].

The new edition of the dictionary has also added a QR code to each page, allowing readers to scan the code (扫码) to learn how to 82 (correct) write a character and hear the right 83 (pronounce). This is the first time that *Xinhua Dictionary* has 84 (bring) out an app and

printed copies at the same time.

The 12th edition of the dictionary does not include too many new characters, 85 it does include more than 100 new words and expressions. Many of 86 are from the Internet, such as “fen si” (fans), “er wei ma” (QR code), and “dian zan” (clicking the “like” button). The new edition has also added more than 50 new usages, including “mai meng” (acting cute), “pin che” (carpool) and “pin gou” (shopping pool).

Since its first edition 87 1953, *Xinhua Dictionary* has sold more than 600 88 (million) copies around the world. The dictionary has been a tool (工具) for several generations of Chinese people. It has become a 89 ['sɪmbl] of Chinese culture. It is also the first dictionary written in modern Chinese. Most, if not all, Chinese people use *Xinhua Dictionary* in 90 ['praɪməri] schools when they start learning Chinese characters.
