

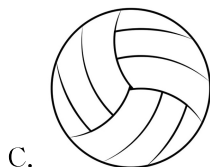
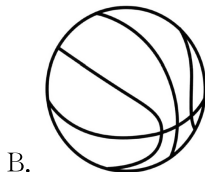

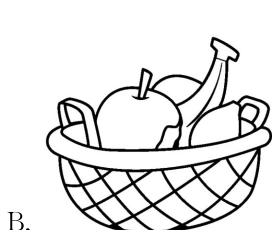

“Without music, life would be a mistake,” famous German philosopher(哲学家) Friedrich Nietzsche said over a century ago. Music is a big part of our lives. But in recent years, some US schools have cut music classes to control budgets(预算).

For example, Chicago public schools hurt arts education when they fired(解雇) over 1,000 teachers. Among them, 10 percent of the teachers taught art or music, according to *The Washington Times*. In fact, this is not just a problem in the US. In other countries, such as China and the UK, music classes are not thought to be as important as the ones like science, math and history. That's partly because music is not seen as a very important life skill, and it isn't tested. Many students are busy with schoolwork, so parents and students choose to focus on subjects that are tested more often.

However, learning music is beneficial(有益的) in many ways. It is not as simple as it looks, according to *Kenneth Guilmartin of Music Together*, an early childhood music development program. For example, when playing the piano, people see music notes and decode(解码) them in their brains. They also use their fingers to make sounds. You need to deal with all these things at the same time.

Music has a special connection with science as well. You can see that many scientists are good at playing music: Einstein played the violin, and German physicist Max Planck was talented in playing the piano.

Ancient civilization (文明) is something that Greeks and Chinese are both proud of. Both countries have had great thinkers and rich culture, tying them together in a long and deep friendship.

President Xi Jinping paid a state visit to Greece in November 10th, 2019. It was an important event between Eastern and Western civilizations in modern times.

Thousands of years ago, when Socrates (469 BC—479 BC) was teaching his students how to be good people in Greece, Confucius (551 BC—479BC) was telling his students that “Virtue (美德) is not to stand alone. He who practices it will have neighbors.” Years after Greek mathematician (数学家) Archimedes (287 BC—212 BC) calculated (计算) the value of Pi (圆周率), Chinese mathematician Zu Chongzhi (429—500) made it more accurate (精确的). These great people’s ideas are still influencing today’s world.

During Xi’s visit, he underlined the need for China and Greece. And there is a lot more that both countries can do together in modern times. Greece is one of the first European countries to take part in China’s Belt and Road Initiative. Today China is investing (投资) more in Greece. It is also importing more Greek agricultural (农业的) products and having more cultural exchanges. These two ancient cultures are joining hands and walking into a brighter future.

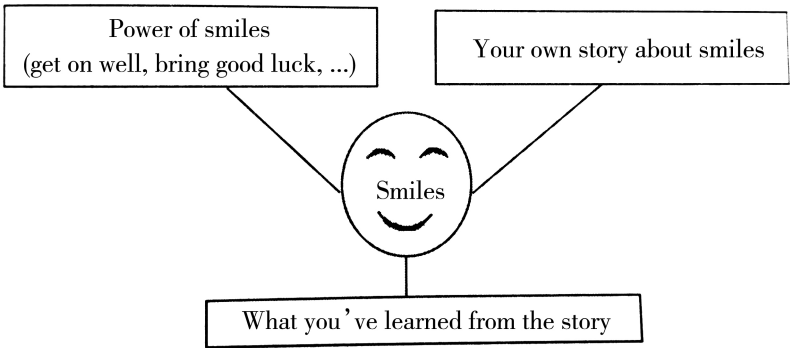
