There are a lot of different people in the world. We all want to get along with others. Humans are social beings, and we enjoy being treated nicely. Getting along with someone isn't about being his or her best friend or sharing all his or her hobbies. It is about treating people with respect and care.

To start a conversation, it is important to listen first, especially when your are in a group. Don't join in the chat when you have just arrived. First, examine the situation and the conversation, and then say whatever you think fit. So it is better to listen to what the conversation is about before speaking.

A little laughter goes a long way, while a frown (皱眉) can make you nervous. If someone plays a joke on you, try to laugh it off. If someone is frowning, smile at him or her. Pay attention to your facial expression. If you are cheerful and **optimistic**, people will cheer up when they see you coming.

Some people do not take the hint (暗示). Some people do not read body language. For these people, it really works to speak with a cheerful face and voice, and show directly that you want to

get along with them.

Being kind is its own reward. It could be as simple as bringing donuts for people or offering to help someone who is trying hard to carry something. This will show you care about other people around you.
