Li has become unable to walk since he got poliomyelitis (小儿麻痹症) at young age. His mother Gu used to carry him to school, but now it is too hard for her to carry a son who weighs more than 75 kilograms.

When the teacher Chen Huiling asked for volunteers from Li's classmates to help carry Li up and down stairs, all 30 boy students from Li's class agreed to lend a hand. The boys are divided into groups of five and take turns carrying Li. When Li rolls his wheelchair to the teaching building every day, a strong classmate carries him on the back, with two assisting(协助) and two carrying his schoolbag and other things. Because of Li's weight, the classmate carrying him might sweat(出

汗) a lot after spending around three minutes climbing stairs to classrooms on the fourth or fifth floor. Li thanks his classmates a lot every day.

A new app can tell you what your dog is thinking. 40 What's more, it can show dogs' feelings, such as "happy", "angry", "sad" and "scared". The app is made by a group of scientists.

The Happy Pets app uses AI, which is a technology used for robots and self-driving cars. 41 Many of us can unlock our mobile phones with our face.

But this is the first time that this kind of technology has been used for animals. These scientists had to make the technology know that the image(肖像) was an animal. It then had to learn to know facial features(特征). This is difficult, because photos can be taken in so many different ways. 42 Once the AI behind Happy Pets had learned all these, it then could decide what kind of feeling a dog was showing. Chinese people like to eat together, but we should know that sharing dishes can spread disease(疾病) easily. Now, the government not only encourages people to use serving utensils at home, but also suggests that restaurants provide people with serving utensils.

Wang Shijia, a restaurant manager in Shanghai, said it was nothing new for them. "We've been providing serving utensils at each table since one year ago, and people like it very much," he said.

However, there are still people who disagree with the idea. In an online survey of 7,500 people on the use of serving utensils, 20% said they were not in the habit and didn't think it necessary. Many also said that it was hard for them to ask others to use serving utensils.

"Behind Chinese table manners is its culture of sharing. One's own utensils mean the person himself, and eating the dish with his utensils suggests the act of joining the group," Lin Yufeng, a researcher of cultural communication at Nanjing University, said. "The culture plays an important role in people's action, so changing the habit of not using serving utensils must start with everyone."

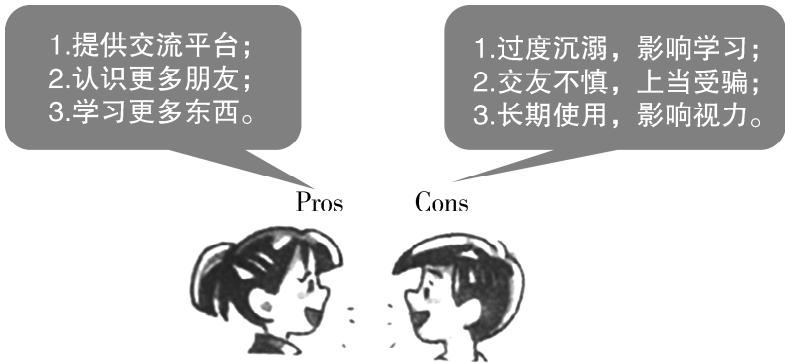
