Los Angeles is the city of Angels. It lies on the southwest coast of the United States. and it is surrounded by mountains and the Pacific. Its area is 4.08 square miles. More than 3 million people live in the city. Instead of lots of skyscrapers(摩天大楼) and shopping malls. Los Angeles vacation should concentrate on a few special neighborhoods within 15 miles between downtown and the ocean, while offers plenty of choices.

Los Angeles is famous for the Hollywood movies. Hollywood is not only the largest movie city in the world, but also has a lot of historic interests. Take a walk down Hollywood Blvd(好莱坞的星光大道) and you 'll pass by famous sights , such as Chinese Theatre, where more than 150 famous persons have left their footprints on the sidewalk. If you walk to the east along the Blvd,step on those statues of stars and you'll find yourself at the Roosevelt Hotel. Another attractive place is Disneyland in Los Angeles. It is the earliest Disneyland in the world. It was built in the 1950s and opened to the public, Very quickly it became to be regarded as one of the wonders of the modern world. In the first six months of its existence, about 3 million people passed through its gate.Visitors to Disneyland included eleven Kings and Queens, twenty- four heads of countries, and twenty-seven royal(王室的)princes and princesses. In ten years , Disneyland earned \$195, 000.000. Now it is still the most attractive place for many tourists.especially the parents with their children.

China is a country with many colorful days and festivals. The Dragon Head Raising Day (Longtaitou) is one of them.

This special day is on the second day of the second month in the Chinese lunar calendar (阴历). It stands for the start of spring and farming. This year, the day fell on March 10. The dragon is important in Chinese culture. We Chinese people call ourselves the “descendants (传人) of the dragon”. Therefore, people celebrate the Dragon Head Raising Day with many customs (传统) about dragons.

On the day in ancient times (古代), people put ashes (灰) in the kitchen. This was to “lead the dragon into the house”. People believed that with the help of the dragon, they could have a good harvest (收成) in autumn. Also, people eat special foods on that day. The foods are usually named after dragons. For example, people eat “dragon whisker (细须)” noodles and dumplings called “dragon teeth”. Today, many customs have faded away (消退). But one that has remained is the cutting of hair. It was said that a haircut during the first lunar month may bring bad luck to the mother’s brothers. So many people have their hair cut on the Dragon Head Raising Day.

On Thanksgiving Day, about 88 percent Americans will eat turkey. But one lucky turkey not only will not be eaten but also will become famous! Every year, turkey farmers present a turkey to the US

president. But instead of eating this turkey, the president gives it a “pardon”. The turkey is flown to Florida for a Thanksgiving Parade (游行). Then it lives on a farm for the rest of its life.

Turkeys come from America and have been part of American culture for centuries. Benjamin Franklin even wanted the turkey to be America’s national bird.

Turkeys that are kept on farms are large, awkward birds that can not fly. But wild turkeys are quite fast. They can fly at speeds up to 88 kilometers per hour. They can also run at 40 kilometers per hour.
