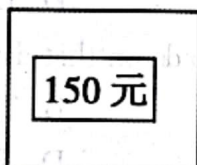

It's not true that girls are any less capable(有才能的) than boys in the left-brain area. They just do far fewer science and math jobs than boys do when they grow up.

Few girls like jobs about science and math, largely because they think they are less proficient(精通的) in those subjects than boys. According to a study, only 15 percent of first year college girls plan to study science, technology, engineering and math. Women make up half of the US workforce, but they only do 20 percent of the jobs in science, technology, engineering and math.

Marcia Bisland says that the program named The Girls, Math & Science Partnership is for girls aged 11 to 17. "They feel safer taking challenges, and feel safer asking questions," she says. "They seem to have more confidence(信心) in the things they have learned in that environment."

As the leader of the program, Bisland hopes to make excitement and energy about math and science among girls. The girls can grow into women who can someday take a growing number of jobs in math and science.

The program is important to girls because so many higher-paying jobs are out there, both now and in the future. In the early school years, girls have much interest in math and science as boys do. However, the girls lose their interest as they get older.

"Even for kids who don't do math and science jobs, learning these subjects well is helpful in their everyday life, such as spending money," Bisland says. "We can't turn them all into scientists, engineers or doctors, but we can at least show them how math and science can be used in

their life."
