The Yangtze River is the longest river in China. For thousands of years, a lot of people have made their living along the river. (11) \_\_\_\_\_

However, since January 1, 2020, China has begun a 10-year ban (禁令) on fishing in conservation areas (保护区) along the Yangtze River. And from January 1, 2021, fishing is not allowed in all natural waterways of large lakes connected to the Yangtze such as the Dongting and Poyang Lake for 10 years.

Many of us enjoy watching wild animals. We can learn a lot from them.

Geese (雁), for example, teach a very good lesson about teamwork. In fall, Canada geese fly to the warm south to get away from Canada's cold winter. They lift off in no order. Yet quickly they form a V shape, with one bird leading.

This V shape allows geese to save energy. When the front bird moves its wings up and down, the force (力量) of the air lifts the next one. This continues down the line. The bird in front has the hardest job. When it gets tired, it moves behind, and another bird moves into the lead. By sharing the role, the group

can travel a great distance. Geese flying in a V shape can fly 70% farther without a rest than birds flying alone.

During the long flying journey, geese communicate with one another. They honk (鸣叫) to encourage the birds to keep up the speed. They also cheer each other up while working towards a common goal.

What have we learned from the lovely geese's experience and skills? Work together! Whether it is our personal lives or our jobs, we need other people. We need the spirit of teamwork!

The world is a greener place today than it was 20 years ago. How does this happen? Well, it appears China is leading the change. The tree-planting programs in China have made huge contributions to the global greening.

Taking a bus or subway, making payments online, or just walking – these daily activities can help turn China's deserts into forests if you are using Ant Forest. It was launched by Ant Financial Service Group.

Ant Forest is a feature (功能) in the Alipay mobile payment app. It records users' low-carbon activities – taking a bus to work instead of driving, for example – and gives users “green energy”. When the user's green energy gets high enough, Ant Forest and its partners will plant a real tree for the user.

Ant Forest recently received the 2019 Champions of the Earth award, the UN's highest environmental honor (荣誉), for encouraging people to live greener lifestyles and protect the environment.

About half a billion people have used Ant Forest since it came out in August 2016. Ant Forest and its

partners have planted about 122 million trees in China's driest areas, including parts of Inner Mongolia, Gansu, Qinghai and Shanxi. The trees cover a total area of 112,000 hectares (公顷). This makes Ant Forest China's largest tree-planting project started by a private company. Ant Forest shows us how we use technology to solve environment problems.

This is only part of the China's efforts to make Earth greener. In 1978, China began national-level forestation project-"Great-Green-Wall". The problem has seen trees planted in 13 provinces of China to act as wind breaks. China is one of the most successful countries in greening the desert.
