Are you a shy person? Do you expect to become outgoing? Being outgoing can help in your life. In fact, being outgoing is not so hard as you think. Here is some advice about how to become outgoing.

You can start to try being outgoing when you stay with your friends. But the challenge (挑战) comes when you meet strangers or new friends. Smile at them, and usually they will smile at you, too. You may find it easy to start talking in this way.
