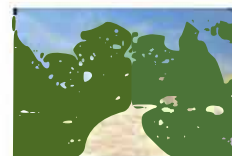

You have just finished eating an apple while on a camp. There aren't any rubbish bin around. What do you do with the apple core(核)? If you answered "throw it in the grass" because you thought fruit would not have a bad influence on nature, you are wrong.

According to the scientists, decomposition (分解) of fruit litter takes much longer time than you imagine. Some of these "natural" food can take years to decompose depending on the environment they are in.

When animals start to get their food from people, they may stop looking for their own food in nature. This is very dangerous because animals need different foods to stay healthy. Food waste-also draws animals to go to areas where there are a lot of people. And when food is thrown out of a car window, animals may develop the habit of searching roadsides for food. It is more likely to be hit by a car.

In fact, apples, bananas and oranges are not from wild forests. If they are eaten by wild animals, they will probably cause the animals to get sick. Seeds(种子) of these fruit or vegetables that end up on the ground could grow into an exotic plant there. It's not good to the local environment. And then, of course, nobody wants to see somebody else's fruit litter, which has already gone bad, while enjoying the beautiful outdoors.

So, no litter is safe litter, not even an apple core.

Some spicy (辣的) food is so good that I really want my dog to try it. Have you ever had that thought? But can dogs eat spicy food? And do they like it?

Dogs actually have far fewer taste buds (味蕾) than humans, according to animal expert. We have about 9, 000 taste buds, while dogs only have around 1, 700. Because of this, dogs aren't able to enjoy some taste as we are. So if you try to feed your dog spicy food, it won't even be able to taste the flavour (味道) that well. It'll just feel the effects of the spice (香料).

Most dogs actually don't like spicy food. They can feel the burning feeling of the spicy food, but they don't taste the flavour as well as humans do. In addition, spicy food can also taste bitter to dogs, which they don't like that much. While dogs' sense of taste isn't as strong as humans', their sense of smell is much better. So your dog will also probably react to some strong smell of something spicy. And it may not want to eat it.

Not all spicy food is dangerous to dogs, but you still shouldn't give your dog any. This is because spicy food can burn its mouth and lead to a stomachache. Besides, spicy food is often salty, so dogs can get sick from eating too much salt.

If your dog accidentally eats some spicy food, you can give it a little milk. Drinking water doesn't actually help with spice. The same is true of people.

So don't give your dog spicy food. It probably won't really like it anyway.

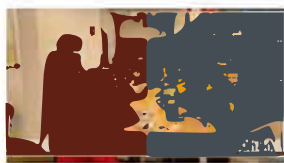
