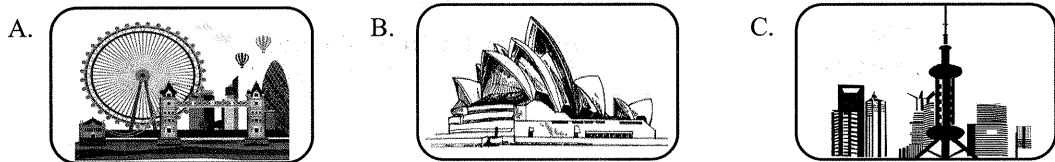

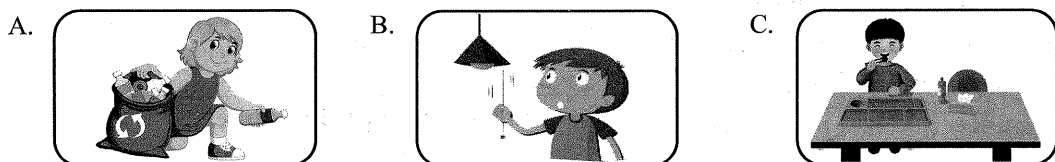

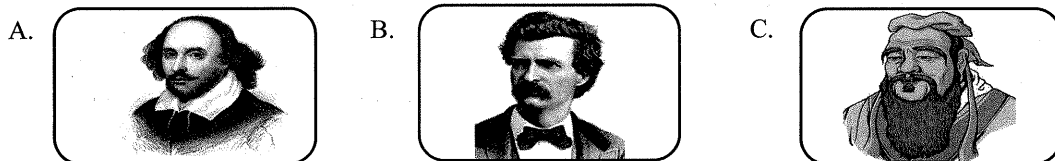

Speaking of the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics, most people would mention skating or skiing, but there's another sport in it: curling.

Curling is called "chess on ice". It's not a speed* game, but a thinking game. It's a sport played by two teams of players who slide* stones on a sheet.

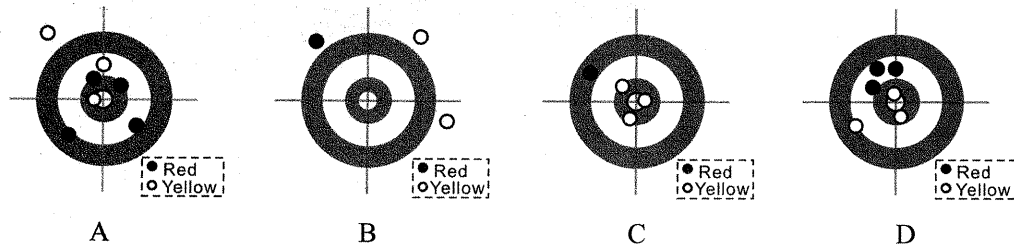
The sheet made of ice is 44.5 meters long and 4.32 meters wide. At the end of the sheet, a target lies on the centre line. The target is also called "the house", in which there are 4 circles.

A curling team is often made up of four players, namely Lead, Second, Third, and Skip. When one player slides the stone, the other two use the brooms to sweep the ice in front of the stone. The sweeping helps smooth the surface* of the ice, and makes sure the stone has a longer ride. At the same time, the Skip, also the team captain, standing in the house, directs play for the team.

The purpose of the game is to get the stones as close to the center of the house as possible. Usually there are 10 rounds in a game. In each round, each team gets eight stones. A team gets a point for each stone that is closer to the center of the house than the other team's best stone. If there is no stone in the house, there is no point. After ten rounds, the team that has higher total points is the winner.

A game of curling usually lasts three hours. There will be about 100 games in the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics, so curling will be the one with the longest broadcast time.

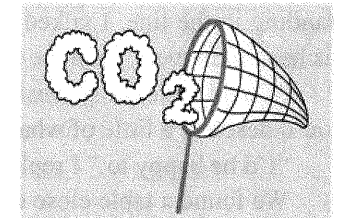

Planting trees can reduce CO₂ in the air, but just doing this isn't enough to deal with climate* change. Now one way discussed widely is carbon capture*. It's a collection of technologies that can protect the earth against climate change by reducing CO₂, a kind of greenhouse gas*.



Carbon capture technology is used to get CO₂ from emissions of factories. For example, it can be fitted to gas and coal-burning power stations and factories, and then uses a liquid to chemically remove* the CO₂ before it goes out. The captured CO₂ can then be liquefied and stored underground. Besides, the technology can also be used to capture CO₂ from the air, to chemically extract* CO₂ that had already gone into it.

Then how can we deal with CO₂ we capture? Proper utilization is of great importance. It can not only help create markets for this new technology, but also make it cheaper for companies to invest in capturing their CO₂ emissions. Nowadays, the main use for CO₂ today is increased oil recovery. CO₂ is also used in greenhouses to grow vegetables. CO₂ could even be made into useful products, such as plastics, building materials, and even household products like baking soda and paints. Some of these products are already being sold.

Carbon capture is considered to be quite helpful. However, there are many problems on the way. There's 50 billion tons of carbon going out to the air from cars and factories every year. But even a great number of the carbon capture machines now can remove only a few tens of tons of it. The concentration* of CO₂ in the air is about 300 times less than that in the power stations or factories, making it much less efficient to capture. Because of this, carbon capture is very expensive today. So, it's hard to make a real difference in fighting climate change now. But it can be improved quickly to be cheaper and more efficient. It is like the mobile phones. Twenty years ago they were expensive and difficult to use but have been improved upon continuously.

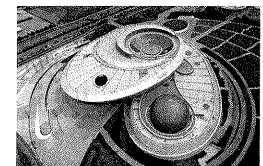

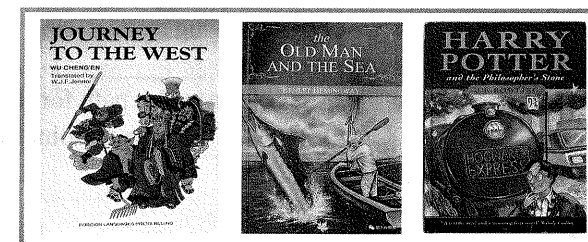
