In ancient times, there was a king who wanted a special kind of horse called *qianlima*, which could run 1,000 *li* a day. Therefore, many people were sent to find these horses and buy them for him over three years. Unluckily, nobody succeeded in finding such a horse.

One day, someone new volunteered to help. Within three months, he heard about a *qianlima*. He rushed to buy it, only to find the horse dead. Still, he bought the bones of the horse with 500 pieces of gold.

The king was very angry about it. “What I want is a live horse, not the bones of a dead horse!” But the man answered calmly, “Imagine this. You’re willing to pay a high price for a dead horse, let alone(更别说) a live one. This shows people you truly wish to buy the horses. Just wait and the horses you want will come very soon.” Indeed, within a year, many *qianlima* owners brought their horses to the king.

Guo told the king he could see himself as the bones of the horse. “If I am valued, more talent will be willing to serve the state,” he said. The king trusted him and treated Guo respectfully. Before long, talented people across the state came to help the king beat the State of Qi and they made it.

The story was written by Han Yu in *Horses*(《马说》). It tells us talented people are important to society and we should actively sell ourselves instead of waiting for someone to find us.

Each year on Feb. 21, UNESCO(联合国教科文组织) holds an International Mother Language Day (IMLD). The event is to help people to pay attention to the disappearance of the world’s languages.

What happens when a language dies out? Something great is lost—not just sounds and words but

the way that people understand the world and communicate with each other.

Through IMLD, more and more people come to realize the terrible situation and try to stop it. Google's 2021 Endangered Languages Project is a good example. Many speakers and protectors of endangered languages upload(上传) texts, MP3s and videos to the project website. They want to introduce the way that people communicate and express themselves around the world.

Another project called The Myamia Project is the same kind of effort to revive(复活) the language spoken by the Miami tribes(部落) of the United States. Project members work to encourage people to study and communicate with this language, which died out in the 1960s.

These protective activities give life to those endangered languages. People who work to keep languages alive are not limited to the past. Many young people design apps and use social media(媒体) to support their activities. They "spread the words" to save the world's languages.

So, while the problem of disappearing languages remains a very serious one, there is hope. We all have a special feeling of our mother languages. This is why we should remember the wise words of the first president of South Africa, Nelson Mandela, "If you talk to a man in a language he understands, that goes to his head. If you talk to a man in his own language, that goes to his heart."

When it comes to Chinese traditional art, painting and dance are two parts which are of great importance in the art world. But what about when they meet each other?

This year, a dance drama titled Poetic Dance: *The Journey of a Legendary Landscape Painting* (《只此青绿》) was on CCTV's Spring Festival Gala and as one of the most eye-catching performances, it was inspired by the 900-year-old Chinese painting *A Panorama of Rivers and Mountains* (《千里江山图》). "Created by Song Dynasty painter Wang Ximeng, the painting impresses people with its big size, rich natural colors, and the expressive details", reported CCTV. It shows a Chinese blue-green picture of land: mountains and groupings of rise and fall between cloudless sky and rippling(波浪起伏的) water.

To show the Chinese traditional art of the painting, the dancers were creatively conceptualized(概念化) as the mountains. When the dancers were making dance movements, people seemed to be looking at the moving mountains and rivers.

"It brings me an enjoyable experience of beauty. It is not only a drama but also an 'exhibition' which shows excellent works of art to the public. Huge mountains and rivers are coming to life!" Mo Weisha wrote in her review. "More than a thousand years later, green mountains and rivers still excite people as they did long ago." Some people even decided to watch the dance again when it was performed in the theaters later.

In fact, in recent years, more and more modern shows give their attention to Chinese traditional culture and have received warm welcome as the result of people's great love for traditional culture.

"People have a more open mind and value tradition more than ever these days. The young take pride in Chinese culture and are fond of it. Hopefully these shows will gain more popularity." Yao Wei, director of Henan TV station said.

Your comfort zone is a place, activity, situation or psychological state(心理状态) in which you feel free from anxiety and things are within your ability or control. But stepping out of it also has positive results.

When you break free and try new things, you'll be more productive(有效率的) and get more unexpected changes. That's because by living outside your comfort zone when you choose to, you can experience uncertainty in a controlled and manageable environment.

Here are some ways to break out of your comfort zone without going too far.

Do everyday things differently.

Ride your bike instead of taking the bus to school. Try a different diet. Use a new operating system. Don't be upset if things don't work out the way you planned.



If you're scared or overwhelmed(难以承受的) by the challenge you picked for yourself, don't do it at once. You can make it a multi-step process that will let you slowly climb that mountain.

Trust yourself and make snap decisions.

Perhaps you are more comfortable weighing all of the possible choices several times, but sometimes making a **snap** decision is a good way to get things moving. Doing so can help you start your personal projects and teach you to trust your judgment(判断).

Yet, with all its possible benefits, you can't live outside of your comfort zone all the time. You need to come back from time to time to review your experiences. Remember to reflect on your experiences so that you can apply the benefits you've got to your day-to-day activities.

Your comfort zone is neither a good nor bad thing. It's a natural state that most people trend towards(倾向于). Leaving it means increased risk and anxiety, which can have positive and negative

results, but don't demonize(妖魔化) your comfort zone as something holding you back. We all need that head space where we're not so stressed that we can process the benefits we get when we leave it.

Do you ever feel like you are running from one activity to another, or studying one subject after another in a rush?

When things happen at such a 74 pace(节奏), it is easy to lose sight of what you are doing, or what you are learning. So it is important to stop yourself every now and then to think about what you've been doing or learning. That is called self reflection(反思).

Self reflection means stopping the rush and calming yourself and your mind so your brain can weigh the information it has already received. Some people prefer to do their self reflections in their minds, 75 others keep written notes. 76 method can work, depending on what your own personal style is. As we know that school textbooks are often 77 into units, which makes it easier for us to start the process of self reflection. Watch out for the times when you complete a unit in any subject you are learning. Sometimes you are reminded that the unit is over because there is some kind of test.

Use these natural breaks 78 chances to stop and reflect. Find a quiet place. This can even be sitting at your desk at school when you finish something early and the other students are still working.

Sometimes just 79 to think deeply allows your brain to make connections so that new information can be quickly recalled when you need it again. Next, think about things that you still wonder. For example, maybe you learned a new way to solve a math problem, but you're not 80 when to use it. Then you can write down your questions, which will help you remember to continue looking for answers the next time you come across the same question.

Self reflection is an important skill for a successful student. If you have never taken the 81 to reflect, try it now. In this way, you will have a better understanding of what you have learned.
