

A package (包裹) has sold very well in Nanjing. It 41 buyers to pay electricity bills for the elderly living in China's poor and faraway areas.

Mao Jiashu, a college student in Nanjing, 43 this idea when she visited Inner Mongolia in 2018.

Sometimes they could not walk the long way to pay in time, so the electricity was cut off," she said. "So I decided to do something to help them and make people know more about their 45."

More than 120 packages were 46 on the first day at a store in Xinjiekou area, and 72 people paid the electricity bills.

Each package, with no real food inside, includes a piece of paper with a 47. Written by a(n) elderly person, the message 48 feelings about life and other things they want to tell the public.

Zhao Le, who paid 20 yuan for one elder, said the message made her feel 49 "They don't 50 ask you for help. They want to pay you back by sharing their life experience with you," she said.

The Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics were more than a sporting event. They were also a show for science and technology. They are helping athletes (运动员) become “faster, higher, stronger” and offering you a great game-watching experience with the support of 5G. Let’s look at some technologies behind the Beijing Winter Olympics.

The fastest ice

The National Speed Skating Oval is said to have “the fastest ice”, as 12 new Olympic records and one world record were set there. The secret is new ice-making technology. Liquid carbon dioxide (液体二氧化碳) is put under the ice to keep temperature changes on the ice surface in half a degree. That keeps the ice a level surface and it is easier to skate on.

“Seeing” the wind

In events like freestyle skiing and ski jumping, the direction and speed of the wind can have great influence on an athlete’s performance. A Chinese research team developed a system to measure wind. The system uses AI technology. It allows athletes and coaches to “see” wind with real-time data (数据) on their Ipads, and decide when and where to jump.

High-speed cameras

During the speed skating race, athletes can reach speeds of up to 18 meters per second. To catch every exciting moment of the competition, Lie Bao has been used for the event.

Lie Bao, is a 4K high-definition (高清) camera system developed by China Media Group(CMG). It can record speeds of up to 25 meters per second. It closely follows the athletes’ movements and catches different scenes during speed skating, according to Shanghai Plus.
