### C

Jia Wei, a 14-year-old from Jilin, is feeling down these days. "From the Ukraine crisis (危机) to the crash of Flight MU5735 to another rise in COVID-19 cases, pieces of bad news come on the heels of one another," Jia said. "I feel confused, sad and scared."

Jia's reaction (反应) shows how people can be affected by traumatic (不幸的) events, even when events didn't directly happen to them.

The situation can get worse if they see frequent (频繁的) media reports. A 2016 study showed that teenagers who often saw information on the 2008 Wenchuan earthquake were 1.45 times more likely to have stress symptoms than those who seldom saw the information. If teenagers often saw pictures and videos of the damage (破坏), they were 1.84 times more likely to have stress symptoms.

How can we deal with stress after upsetting news? We talked with psychologist (心理学家) Li Songwei, who got his doctorate (博士学位) from Peking University.

Q: Is it normal to feel scared or upset after getting bad news?

A: Yes, it's normal. Some people may have difficulty sleeping, or nightmares, or disaster-related images (灾难相关画面) flashing in their minds during the daytime. These symptoms are called "acute stress responses (急性应激反应)". They can be caused by seeing images of things like blood or dead bodies. They normally disappear within a month.

Q: What can we do to deal with our bad feelings?

A: Try to avoid images that make you feel uncomfortable. Stay informed (了解情况) by reading text or talking with people. At the same time, we need to understand that bad things happen. Uncertainty and imperfection are parts of the world. Only by facing it can we deal with it better.

Q: What if we can't help checking our phones?

A: Learn about time management. For example, spend half an hour reading news and then put your phone away. Focus on things like exercise and studying so that you won't be affected by negative (负面的) feelings for too long.

#### Some Amazing Apps for Your Smartphone

It's hard to imagine life in modern society without smartphones. Here are a few free and helpful apps that you can download to help you throughout the day.

If you have a habit of forgetting things and want to organize your life, give Evernote a try. It promises to help users remember everything. With a few clicks, you can send all of your photos, documents, and audio notes to your Evernote. Then your digital information can be stored in folders or tagged (标签) with useful keywords. When you need to access (访问) this data(数据), you can perform a simple search and it will appear in seconds. Evernote can be used on smartphones, iPads, and computers, so you can access your data from everywhere.

Imagine you're watching a TV show and you hear a cool song in the background. You want to buy it but there's one problem: You don't know the name of the song. SoundHound is an app that will make this problem a thing of the past. It can make us quickly identify (识别) songs. The app takes the song playing and compares it to thousands of other songs. Within seconds, it can tell you the name, artist, and album of the song you just heard.

Another wonderful app is Lookout. Hopefully you won't have to use it often, but when you do need it, Lookout can be a lifesaver. Its main function (功能) is to help you find your phone if it goes missing. Lookout does this by using your smartphone's data connection to locate (定位) your lost device. To see where your phone is on a map, simply log into Lookout from any web browser (浏览器). In the worst-case situation, if someone steals your phone, you can delete all of its data with a few clicks. This will be sure that no one will see any private information on your phone.

We've covered a few helpful apps but this is just the tip of an iceberg (冰山). If you do some searching online, you're certain to find lots of other apps that will make your life more convenient.
