An old steel-making center in Beijing is getting new life as a place for shopping, eating and working. It is also being shown on televisions during this year's Winter Olympics. It has large



cooling towers and smokestacks (烟囱), which were used for dealing with pollution and heat. They get attention when they are seen with the ski jumping competition known as "Big Air". A 64-meter-high, 164-meter-long ramp (坡道) also appears in the competition. It is

used to gain speed before the skiers jump into the air and do tricks.

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China closed the steel factory before the 2008 Summer Olympics to cut down air pollution. Since then, the factory has been turned into a place where people work, eat and walk on grassy areas. The old parts of the factory are still there. But many of the spaces have been turned into offices.

Big Air skiing usually takes place in mountain ski areas or in temporary (临时的) places inside sports fields. Other Big Air events in the world use materials that are easy to take down when the event ends. But Chinese hope that Beijing will be a place for future competitions. The competitors like the ramp because it is secure. When they compete on temporary ramps, they do not feel as safe. Some of them think the ramp is as good as the ones in the mountains although it is in the city. They are able to do their usual tricks without worrying about running out of space. American skier Nick Goepper said more competition places like the one in Beijing would help the sport find new fans since more people can see the event in cities.

The ramp in Beijing is built into a larger seating area and will be used for concerts and other performances.

Navigation (导航) is an important ability for animals to find food and living places. Researchers in Israel have performed an experiment and found that goldfish are able to navigate on land after receiving around 10 driving lessons.

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The experiment was led by a research team at the Ben-Gurion University. It was made to see whether goldfish could find their way in a very different environment. Researchers developed a robotic car that could drive forward, backward, and from side to side. They called the car a FOV—"Fish Operated Vehicle" (鱼驱动车). A goldfish was placed inside a water box on the FOV. Using a set of wheels with a camera system, the FOV recorded the fish's movements and swimming directions, then moved in the same direction.

The scientists worked with six different goldfish. They placed the car in a small room with a pink target (目标) on one side. The fish would get food when the car touched the target. After a few days of training, the fish navigated to the target. At first, it took them about half an hour to drive to the target. But by the end of the experiment, they were able to complete the same task in less than a minute. Shachar Givon, one of the researchers said, "As anyone who has tried to learn how to ride a bike or to drive a car knows, it is challenging at first."

Not only did the goldfish show that they could drive to the target, they weren't fooled by false targets of other colors. They were also able to get free when the car hit a wall.

Although the fish may not have realized they were moving on land, these results show that a fish has the ability to navigate outside its natural environment of water. It can enrich scientific knowledge of animals' navigation skills.

"I'm glad you could all come," Uncle Luis led the class to a row of trees that were heavy with red apples. "Northern California is a wonderful place to grow apples," he said. "We have a lot of the weather they like—rainy springs, warm summers, and cool nights. Every fall, I hire (fi) some people to come and help me pick apples. They work long days, seven days a week, just to make sure that the apples are picked at the right time."

"Once all the apples are picked, what do you do all winter? Do you get to go on vacation?" asked Kelly. Uncle Luis laughed. "There is still a lot of work to do in the orchard during the winter. How often do you or someone you know leave food on your plate? Does your family throw away food from the fridge because it's no longer fresh? If food waste is a problem in your home, think about what it's like worldwide.

People waste about one-third of all food in the world. To give you an idea of how shocking that is, consider that the waste weighs as much as 200 million elephants! Among the waste, 45% of fruits and vegetables are wasted, 35% of seafood, and 30% of grains. Milk products and meat are also wasted, but not as much. Most of this waste happens in North America and Europe, where about 100 kg of food per person is wasted each year. Up to 40% of the food in the United States is never eaten. The United States wastes so much food that it could feed most of the country's hungry people for one year.

Food waste is a really big problem. It costs money and hurts the environment. Wasting food also raises social questions. But there are ways we can reduce (减少) the food we throw away. One way is to recycle the food we do not eat. Unwanted food breaks down and goes back into the soil to grow more fruits and vegetables. We could also buy less at the supermarket. We should take time to think about how much food we will actually eat. Another way to reduce food waste is to join charity (慈善) organizations and create activities that give food to people who often go hungry.

To reduce food waste is a big task, and it needs time. If we all make the decision to stop wasting food, we can make a difference!
