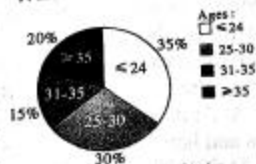

When things around the house stop working, what do you usually do with them? If you're like a lot of people, you 56 just throw them away.

In some areas, it's difficult to find people who can make repairs, and 57 things can be quite expensive. Also, some small objects are so expensive that it's often 58 to just buy a new one.

In 2009, Martine Postma from the Netherlands decided there must be a better way. Her solution was Repair Cafes: places where people can take broken things. There they will find tools, resources and volunteer experts 59 are ready to help with repairs.

Postma's first Repair Cafe opened on Oct. 18, 2009, in Amsterdam, and was a huge 60. News of the cafe 61, and people began asking how they could start their own neighbourhood repair group. In 2011, Postma set up the Repair Cafe Foundation. This nonprofit (非盈利的) organization provides guidance (指导) to those who hope to begin 62.

Today, there are about 2,000 Repair Cafes around the world with meetings usually taking

place once a month. Around 25 objects are repaired during each meeting and everything is free. The cafes not only provide help with repairs, they also build stronger community 63. Neighbors get to know one another as they work together 64 projects. Moreover, 65 knowledge is passed along. Things are kept rather than thrown away, meaning less rubbish.
