A new report said 59.5% of the family had cats as their pets among the 30,000 people surveyed for a research. As of last year, there were some 58 million pet cats in China's city houses, compared with 54 million pet dogs. China has seen an increase in pet ownership over the years, with people increasingly choosing cats. All over the world, though dogs are still more common pets including the United States and the United Kingdom, cats have become the most popular pets in the European Union lately. Experts think the fast growth of cat pets is because of the lifestyle in Chinese cities. Many city people have busy lives and smaller houses, making cats their ideal partners — it's easy to raise cats, unlike dogs that require more attention and outdoor activities.



The research shows that most of the pet owners are people born after 1990 and 1995. Young people are looking for freedom in their lives, and the habits of cats are more suited to their needs. Miss Cai, a 27-year-old who works in Beijing, said she recently kept a cat named Nanako. She thought cats were the perfect pets for working people. "I wanted a dog at first, but since I'm quite busy, I wouldn't have given them enough time," she said. "Cats are more independent compared with dogs. Nanako has stayed with me through my loneliness, and someone who works in a big city like me often faces loneliness."

Guyu, or Grain Rain, is the sixth solar term according to the traditional Chinese lunar calendar, making it the last term of spring. The term usually arrives around April 19-21. This year, it falls on April 20. The Grain Rain means the end of cold weather and a rapid rise in temperature. It comes from the old saying, "Rain brings the growth of hundreds of grains," which shows that this period of rainfall is important for grains. Grain Rain brings a marked increase in temperature. It's also an important time to protect plants from many kinds of insects.



In southern China, people traditionally drink tea on the day of Grain Rain. Spring tea during Grain Rain can help to remove (去除) heat from the body and is good for the eyes. Drinking tea on this day is also said to prevent bad luck.

People in northern China traditionally eat Chinese toon, a kind of vegetable during Grain Rain. An old Chinese saying goes "Chinese toon before the rain is as gentle as silk." The vegetable can help to make the immune (免疫) system strong. It is also good for the stomach and skin.

The Grain Rain festival is celebrated in fishing villages across the northern China. Grain Rain marks the start of the fishermen's first fishing trip of the year. The custom dates back more than 2,000 years ago, when people believed the gods protected them from the stormy seas. People would lay out the fruits and desserts, wishing a safe trip for their loved ones on the Grain Rain festival.

If someone said they'd pay you \$1,800 (¥11796) to stay off social media for six years, would you do it? Could you? Sivert did just that.

In 2016, Loma challenged her 12-year-old son Sivert to stay off social media until he was 18. If he completed the challenge, she'd give him the money on his eighteenth birthday. On February 19, 2022, Sivert got his prize.



Lorna got the idea from a challenge she heard on TV. Sivert said it wasn't too difficult to live without social media, and he didn't think about it much during the six years. As a 12 year old, Sivert said he wasn't using social media much anyway. The only app he had was Snapchat — which he deleted a day after trying it out.

"There wasn't a time I thought I was about to break," he said. "As it went on, it was more of a pride thing." He had his friends keep him up to the latest information. He got to avoid all the unnecessary dramas. It also meant he had more time on his studies, hobbies and sports instead. Now \$1,800 richer, Sivert hasn't thought about what to buy (when he was 12, he joked he'd get a house), but it'll likely be something for his room at his university, which he'll attend in the fall.

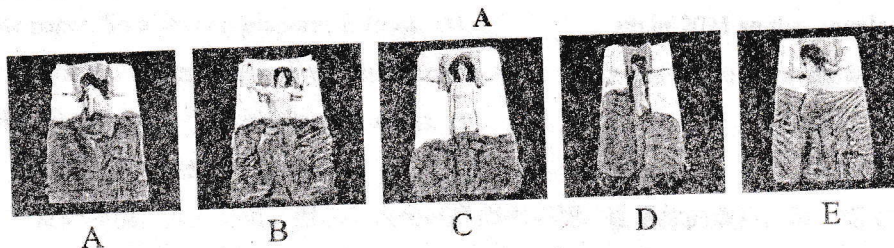

What kind of shape are you in when you sleep? Let's see the following.

1. The Log (木头) Position

For those who hurt from back pain, the log position could be helpful for you. While in a log position, a sleeper has both their arms and legs straight, so their body is like a log. Log sleepers trust others easily, but are usually social and easy-going.

2. The Starfish Position

When sleeping like a starfish, you lie on your back with arms up. Starfish sleepers value friendship, and they prefer not to be the center of attention, people who sleep in this position are good listeners and quick to help others. If you have a starfish sleeper as a best friend, you're lucky.

3. The Freefall Position
