Yue Opera, also known as Shaoxing Opera, is the second most popular Chinese opera type. It started in Shaoxing, Zhejiang province, and has found a second home in Shanghai. The Yue Opera film Dream of the Red Chamber 《红楼梦》 was a classical artwork in this opera type, which is based on the main parts of the Chinese novel of the same name by Cao Xueqin.

Yue Opera actress Chen Yu enjoyed listening to this kind of opera when she was young. She first started learning this traditional Chinese art form at the age of 17. And then Chen became a Yue Opera actress and plays young woman roles.

Chen began singing on short video platforms (平台) in April. As a 36-year-old opera actress, she often practices so as to improve her skills. Chen has deep love for the tradition and gives performances on live-streaming Apps to promote (促进) this culture.



Chen Yu introduced, before every live she will spend an hour or so dressing up. Few people would like to watch her at first, but she kept going live. Tomb Sweeping Day is a one-day Chinese holiday that has been celebrated in China for centuries. Every year in early April, tens of thousands of people in China visit the tombs of their ancestors to show their respect.

On the day, Chinese families will sweep the tombs and clean away the grass around them. Then they burn paper money and put flowers and fruit in front of the tombs. They hope the dead can enjoy them and bring the family good luck.



However, it is not only the Chinese who remember the dead. People in other countries also have festivals for the dead.

In Japan, O-Bon Festival is one of the most important festivals. It is held from August 13 to 16. It is also a holiday that serves as a family reunion (团圆). During O-bon, Japanese people return to their hometown and visit their ancestors' tombs. They also believe their ancestors' spirits return home to be reunited with their family. People perform a “bon odori” dance to welcome the spirits. On the last day of O-bon, they put paper lanterns in a river to send off the spirits.

In Russia, people remember their ancestors on the Day of Rejoicing (欣慰). It's usually in late April or early May. The name of this festival means birth and happiness. Russians believe that people shouldn't feel sad for the dead because death means birth in another world. On the Day of Rejoicing, Russian people draw beautiful pictures on eggs and put them in front of tombs. After that they have a picnic together. They hope for a good life for both the living and the dead.

Jiang Mengnan, 30 years old, comes from Yizhang, Chenzhou, Hunan Province. She couldn't communicate like common people. However, through hard working, she was excellent at school and university. In 2018, she achieved her dream of studying for a PhD at Tsinghua University. And this year, she will graduate. Her story touched many people, and she was honored as an inspirational role model in last year's *Touching China* awards.



Born into an ethnic Yao (瑶族) family in Yizhang county, Jiang's world has been silent since she was 6 months old. The medicine she was given irreparably (不可挽回地) hurt her hearing. Jiang's parents began showing her how to understand people by reading lips when she just learned to walk. It was a slow process. But her parents did not give up, and soon Jiang began to speak.

When she was old enough, Jiang studied at a standard primary school, not a special school as was common for most disabled children. She said it was difficult at first. During lessons, teachers would often write on the blackboard with their backs to the students, it wouldn't influence other students. But, Jiang always missed much of the content (内容) for this reason. She had to copy down everything on the blackboard in the lesson. After class, she must study alone to keep up with her classmates. After years' hard working, she was admitted (承认) to Jilin University in 2011.

She knew the support from others was important on her own journey, so she visited many special school during her vacations. "I've received so much help from others over the years. The best way to repay them is for me to do something good for society. If I can do something to make others less hard, it will be a very meaningful thing," she said. We believed she could do it with her strong will.

With the support of technology, service robots with many kinds of uses have played important roles in Shanghai's fight against the latest COVID-19 outbreak.

Inside a hospital in Shanghai New International Expo Centre, the first 28 "disinfection (消毒) robots" have been put into use. Each of them can work 24 hours a day is prepared with three disinfection tools.

In the meantime, a group of "5G indoor cloud robots" can deliver (运送) over 20 boxed meals at a time, and go to named places for patients to get their food themselves. With the help of these robots, the efficiency (效率) of meals delivery has been greatly improved.

The service robots have helped to lower the risk of cross-infection (交叉感染) between patients and they can also work without troubling the medical staff.
