This year, several young athletes have shone brightly at the Beijing Winter Olympics, giving us a glimpse (一瞥) of their generation's nature.

Obviously, the young generation is filled with "brave warriors (战士)" who want to challenge (挑战) impossibilities and push boundaries(界限). Freestyle skier Gu Ailing is a good example. After she finished strong in the first two jumps in the women's free ski Big Air event (自由式滑雪女子大跳台比赛), it was certain that she could get a medal. But instead of playing it safe, the 18-year-old skier pushed herself to the limit. On the last jump, Gu decided to attempt a difficult trick (技巧).

"I have never done the 'left 16' before. I hadn't prepared much for it apart from (除了) two days on the air bag," Gu told *China Daily*, "but I felt it was a chance to push myself to the limit."

For these young athletes, the sport is never just about scores, but also about having as much fun as possible.

When questioned by *The Guardian*, the "post-00" said, "It doesn't really matter if other people are happy or not, because I feel I'm doing my best and I'm enjoying the entire process."

Gu's good friend, Chinese snowboarder Su Yiming also shares a similar attitude. After he was judged to have lost the gold to Canadian athlete Max Parrot in the men's slopestyle final, the 17-year-old didn't feel upset. Instead, he was happy to have the chance to compete with his idol (偶像).

Su told *China Daily*. "All I did today was enjoy the runs and concentrate on my tricks. As long as I am on my snowboard, I am happy."

This is young generation that dares to push the limits but also enjoys life.

Most 15-year-olds are worrying about their math homework and trying to fit in with other kids their age. But Henry Patterson is busy running a successful online business instead.

Patterson, a teenager from Bedfordshire, a county in the East of England, started a business called Not Before Tea when he was just nine. He began by selling sweets, but soon turned to household products like wash bags and soft toys. The items he sells feature (以.....为特色) characters from a book he wrote called *The Adventures of Sherb and Pip*.

A box of strawberries is left to rot (腐坏) in your fridge. Without any hesitation (犹豫), you throw it away. But it's more than just strawberries that you are wasting.

The life of a strawberry starts from a seed. A farmer plants it and waters it. Later, people pick it and pack it in a box. A truck takes it far--perhaps 200 to 1,000 km--to a supermarket. Water, labor (劳动), fuel (燃料) and money must all be spent in order for a strawberry to come to you. ▲

It's hard for people to realize how much work goes into the food we eat every day. That makes food waste a big problem around the world. Every year, 1.3 billion tons of food is wasted around the world. That's one-third of the total amount of food we have. In China alone, people waste 35 million tons of food each year, according to CCTV.

As we throw food away, there are still 820 million people living in hunger around the world. Many children go to sleep hungry, and 3.1 million of them die of hunger each year, according to the UN. The COVID-19 pandemic (新冠) has made the situation even worse. With many countries no longer transporting food to other countries during this time, 10,000 more children are dying of hunger each month, according to the UN.

"Wasting food means wasting natural resources (资源) and missing the opportunity to feed a growing population in the future," said UN Food and Agriculture Organization Director-General (粮农组织总干事) Qu Dongyu. It's time to take action now.

When you talk about two people who do not get along well together, you say "they are like oil and water" – and here is why.

You'll need

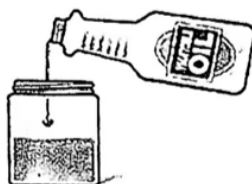
- Clear glass or plastic jar with lid
- Water
- Vegetable oil
- Dishwashing detergent (洗洁精)



1 Fill jar halfway with water, close lid and shake. What does the water do?



2 Pour a small amount of oil in jar, close lid and shake. What do you see in the jar now? Wait for an hour and look again.



3 Add some detergent to jar, close lid and shake again. What do you see in the jar now? Wait for an hour and look again.



What happened?

Oil and water form separate layers in the jar, even after you shake them together.



That's because oil can not *dissolve* (溶解) in water. Adding detergent, however, changes the oil *droplets* (滴) so they dissolve in water.
