The Northern Hemisphere (北半球) moves deeper into autumn. The daylight hours get 21 and the weather colder. This means the gardening season is ending, right?

Well, not so fast.

Lee Reich is a gardener and writes for *The Gardening Today*. He 22 about his thoughts on growing plants in and around the home.

In mid-October, Reich was cleaning up his garden in northern New York when he heard a weather report on the radio. It said the cold weather was coming, and this would put a/an 23 to the gardening season.

“The weather reporter may know about weather”, Reich writes, “but he is not a 24.”

To Reich, 25 weather does not mean the end to gardening. He agrees that his more tender (娇嫩的) vegetables and flowering plants will die when temperatures 26 to 1.6 °C.

However, in his writing, Reich writes about what is 27 growing in such a cold. “Even with a frost (霜冻)”, he says, “there are still leaves on the trees turning beautiful colours of red, yellow and orange.”

Reich also suggests 28 your garden. Some areas may not be as cold as others. A wall or a tree can stop temperatures from dropping as low as in more open areas. Reich notes that some flowering plants growing next to the west side of his house still look 29 and strong.

Gardeners tell us that colder weather does not have to mean you finish your gardening, although the ground should look 30 and dead. With some planning, you can enjoy something in your garden even during the cold weather.

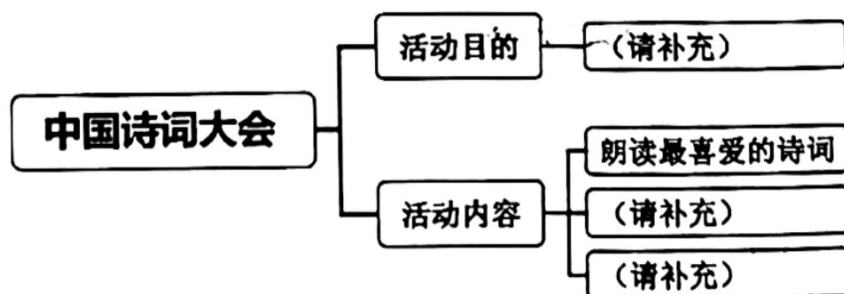
