◆ In Zimbabwe

◆ In Japan

◆ In India

◆ In Russia

Vodka (伏特加酒) might seem a perfect gift for a Russian, but in fact, a lot of them would see it as an unimaginative gift. Many even think the idea is terrible.

◆ In Ireland
