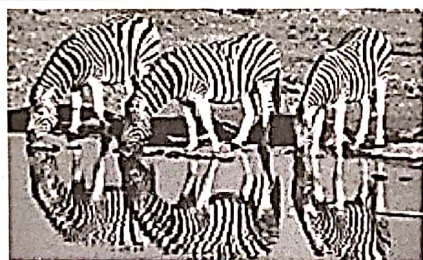

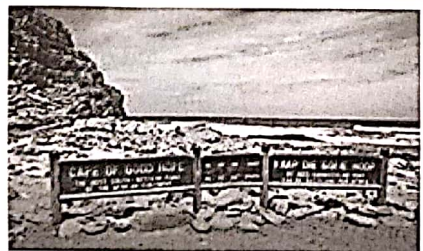

"Wow. This pizza is wonderful."

"How did it taste? It must be yummy!"

"Just close your eyes and try it!"

Whether they love it or not, humans love talking about their food. And those words have an influence(影响) on the experience and feelings of people eating that food.

A research team in the USA decided to study how words would influence our taste. They chose chocolate chip cookies, to test if a word or two could "change" the taste of this food.

In the study, fifty-eight people were asked to try three small bags of chocolate chip cookies and then give each bag a mark, to decide which had the best taste. But they did not know that the three cookies were in fact the same kind, with only one difference—how they were labeled(标签).

▲ The "New and Improved" cookies got a higher mark than the "Factory Special" ones, and a much higher mark than the "Customer Complaint(抱怨)" ones. When the first cookies were described as things like sweet, soft and chewy, the cookies in the third bag were dry, bitter, and too sour.

What makes these words work? It is something known as bias(偏见). Bias is a condition where our experience is influenced ahead of time by some information. About food, it can be a smell, or something we see. It can be an unclean table at a restaurant, or a friendly waiter. It can even be a situation—like being with good friends, or celebrating an event—that can turn just-okay food into a big dinner!

A common weed(野草) growing around Australia could help send humans to Mars, thanks to the work of South Australian scientists.

Duckweed is a bright green water plant that grows quickly and is rich in nutrients(营养物). And it might be the key to producing food for astronauts going on long journeys in space.



Jenny Mortimer works on the duckweed project at the University of Adelaide. She said it was almost impossible to take enough food on a long space journey, such as the one to get to Mars and back.

A trip to Mars with a team of four astronauts will need about 10,000 kilos of food. "You can't take that with you because you don't have enough room and each kilo you take with you to space costs around \$20,000," said Mortimer.

"The International Space Station is amazing, but it's only 400 kilometres above the earth, too far to reach from Mars."

Scientists think of flying things to Mars before astronauts are sent up there. The problem is that the food would have to be able to last for long. And it can be really boring if you have to eat the same things day after day.

"Astronauts can go through something called menu fatigue(菜单疲劳). Even though their food is healthy, they'll lose weight because they just stop eating."

Mortimer believes that duckweed can grow on spaceships and even underground on Mars, using LED lighting. Next, food scientists will work out ways to make duckweed more delicious. "Maybe they can make something that tastes like cheese or yoghurt, but that's a research project for the next five to seven years," she said.
