We often see people waiting in lines at supermarkets, theaters and parks. To our surprise, they even have to wait in line at the top of Qomolangma. —the most Dangerous Mountain in the world. one of the world's most dangerous sports is climbing, and one of the most popular places for this is the Himalayas.

During this year's climbing season, a lot of climbers couldn't move in a long line near the top. The line is above the mountain's highest campsite (宿营地) —about 8000 meters above sea level.

However, most people can only spend a few minutes at the top without extra oxygen supplies (额外的氧气补给). Twenty-one climbers have died in the Himalaya Mountains so far this year. Eleven of these climbers died on Qomolangma.

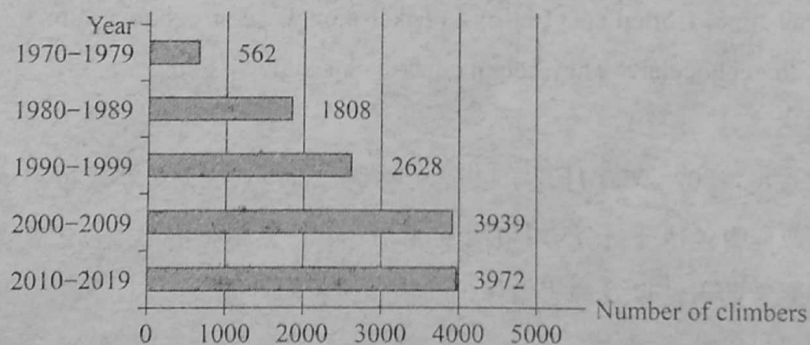
To many people, lack of experience and bad weather have been the most common reasons of death, USA Today reported.

After these tragedies (悲剧), one question is: Why do so many people risk their lives to climb the mountains?

The answer to the question is different for different people. Some people who take risks believe they are different from others. For others, reaching the top of Qomolangma is a lifelong dream.

"Qomolangma is like a light that interests people once they hear about it. It's a best chance for people to challenge themselves," climber Alan Arnette said.
