What do people need to light their houses and drive their cars? Energy! It gives power to many things. Most of the energy comes from coal, oil, and gas. We call them fossil fuels(化石燃料). Those fuels come from fossils under the ground.

Burning fossil fuels pollutes the air. The air becomes dirty. That can be bad to people, animals, and plants.

Now more people are using clean energy. Such energy does not pollute the air. Two kinds of clean energy are wind power and solar power.

Solar Power

The sun gives Earth heat and light. Some houses have solar panels (太阳能电池板) on the roof. The panels keep sunlight and turn it into electricity. We use electricity to light our houses and watch television. Solar power can also be used to warm up the water in our homes.

Wind Power

People use wind turbines (风力涡轮机) to turn wind energy into electricity. Wind turbines are put together in groups in wind farms. Some wind farms have a large numbers of wind turbines. There are more than 160,000 in Inner Mongolia. They can give power to 6 million homes.

Rachel Carson was born in the USA on May 27, 1907. Her mother, Maria Carson, was a school teacher. She loved nature and showed Rachel the beauty of it. She also loved books and taught little Rachel to read. Later Rachel fell in love with books too. At a very early age, she dreamed to be a writer some day. Her story first appeared in a children's magazine when she was ten years old.

Her first book, *Under the Sea-Wind* was a book about a sea bird, a fish and an eel, and their life in the open seas. In 1948, Miss Carson began working on her another book, *The Sea Around Us*. She always learned about the sea carefully before she wrote. She collected information from more than one thousand places to write the book. When the book came out in 1951, it won the National Book Award. It was No.1 on the best-seller list for more than a year. It made Rachel Carson famous and rich enough to leave her job and spend all her time writing. In the book called *The Edge of the Sea*, Carson told what happened to life in and near the sea.

Rachel Carson's most famous book, *Silent Spring* came out in 1962. In this book, She pointed out that the use of some kinds of pesticides (杀虫剂) like DDT would make the number of birds decline because it would kill them. Finally, in November 1969, the United States government, decided to give up using DDT in two years.

Rachel Carson died in 1964. She will be remembered by the world as a great writer.
