In the early days, many people in San Francisco came from China. Some worked as labours (劳工) in the gold fields, and others on railroads (铁路). These were poor people when they first came to America. They worked very hard to make a living.

When the Chinese could afford to they built houses much like their homes in China. Some opened stores to sell products from China to other Chinese. Others opened restaurants to serve Chinese food. These people enjoyed the things they were used to having in their homeland. Today Grand Avenue is the main street to the very large Chinese-American community called Chinatown.
