

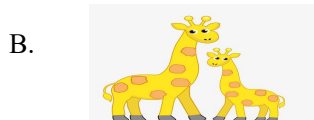

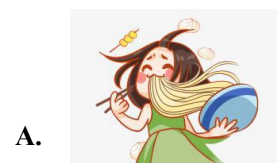

Your car will change in the next 10 years. One of the biggest changes is that cars will drive themselves.

The American company Google has been working on self-driving automobiles for years. These cars are already on the roads in the United States, mainly in California.

Google cars are truly self-driving. These cars have no steering wheels(方向盘) or pedals(踏板).

According to Google, its self-driving cars have been driven nearly 2 million kilometers. That is equal to the distance an average person drives in 90 years. So far, no Google self-driving car has got a **traffic ticket**. Some of them have been in accidents when other cars hit them.

Another American company, Tesla, adds an “Autopilot(自动驾驶系统)” to its cars. Tesla put the computer software program in cars that were built after September, 2014.

With the Autopilot turned on, the car drives itself. The car will speed up, slow down, brake(刹车)and steer(行驶) by itself.

You can take over driving any time by turning the steering wheel or touching a pedal. Your car will slow down if the car in front of you gets closer. It will turn at bends and change lanes(车道) if you use the turn signal.

Tesla's Autopilot takes over driving at a speed of over 29 kilometers per hour when you press a button twice. Autopilot is made for cross-country driving. **It** keeps you in the lane and helps you avoid hitting other cars.

Other companies such as Mercedes-Benz, Audi, BMW, Volvo and Toyota are working on self-driving cars, too. Another company called BestMile is working on self-driving buses in Switzerland. The buses can hold up to nine people and will be tested for two years.

Chinese kung fu is one of the most well-known examples of traditional Chinese culture. It is probably one of the earliest and longest lasting sports. But compared with the common sports, it's very different. In sports like ball games, weightlifting and boxing, a professional athlete has to finish his sports career in his 30s, because injuries caused by active sports at a young age can be harmful for his health in later life. But by doing kung fu, you not only exercise your body but also train your spirit and mind. It is helpful for our physical and mental health.

Chinese kung fu can be dated back to ancient times. During the Zhou Dynasty, martial arts(武术) was taught to children as a part of education. By the Tang Dynasty, it was gradually introduced to many countries in Southeast Asia such as Singapore and Philippines. Chinese kung fu developed very quickly in the Ming and Qing dynasties. Over its long history, it has developed as a unique combination(组合) of exercise, practical self-defense(实用防身术) and art. Since the 1960s, hundreds of martial arts schools have been set up around the country.

In the 1970s, as a great number of kung fu TV series and movies were screened, many kung fu stars, such as Bruce Lee, Jackie Chan and Jet Li, appeared. They are still very popular among kung fu fans and children today. Since the film *Shaolin Temple* was on, *Shaolin Temple* has become a great attraction to many people. Shaolin kung fu is also well-known at home and abroad.
