### 第三节语篇理解

Ray Charles is a black singer and pianist of the USA. He has won 12 Grammy Awards and performed at 10,000 concerts around the world. Ray Charles was born into a poor family, without a father. When he was 5 years old, something was wrong with his eyes. By the age of 7, he was completely blind. He had already been learning the piano for a year, and when he went blind, his mother knew this would be the only way he would make any money in the future. So she encouraged him to go on learning the piano. Later he went to a school for blind and deaf children. There the teachers also encouraged him to study music. Sadly, while he was still at school, his mother died. He left school and in the early 1950s Charles made a group of players. He sang, played the piano and wrote music. He made many classical CDs with famous artists such as Elton John and the Beatles. In 2003 a film of his life Ray was made. The film of his life has been as popular as his songs.

Life is full of the unexpected, just like Ray's. You never know what will happen tomorrow. When you come across the unexpected, all you can do is to face them bravely. It may open another door for you and the key to it is never giving up. It's up to you.

### 第四节听力填空

本题你将听到一篇短文。请你根据所听内容，完成下面的表格，并将获取的信息填到答题卡相应的位置上。每空一词。读两遍。

Do you still remember the 24 solar terms in the opening ceremony of the Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics? Today we'll come to one of them. It's called Awakening of Insects.

Awakening of Insects, or Jingzhe, is the **third** solar term in the Chinese calendar. This year it will fall on March 5th. In Chinese, *Jing* means awakening (唤醒) and *Zhe* refers to hibernating (冬眠的) insects. Ancient Chinese believed that insects **slept** through the winter and were awakened by spring thunder (春雷). Spring thunder is the most **valuable** during this period. As an old Chinese saying goes, "Once the Awakening of Insects comes, spring ploughing (春耕) never rests." So our Chinese put great **importance** on Awakening of Insects and regard it as the time to begin doing farm work.

Awakening of Insects means insects begin to wake up **gradually** and signals a rise in temperature and increased rain fall. It also marks the beginning of a busy season.
