Bungee Jumping: People on some South Pacific (太平洋) islands have been bungee jumping for hundreds of years. In 1979, some people bungee jumped off a bridge in England and made the sport popular around the world. Bungee jumping came to China in 1996.

	Skateboarding: At first, this sport was called "sidewalk surfing". Skateboarders often jump high into the air, go down steps or slide (滑动) down rails on their boards. They wear baggy trousers so they can move more freely.
	Skydiving: This is probably the scariest extreme sport. Skydivers jump out of airplanes about four kilometers up in the sky. They usually fall freely for a while and then open a parachute (降落伞) to slow down for a safe landing.
	Snowboarding: This became a winter Olympic sport in 1998. People tied their feet to the board with special shoes. They don't use any ski sticks. Then, they ride down hills, jump high and do tricks.

#### B

When someone falls from the fourth or fifth floor, and is still alive, we call it a miracle (奇迹). When a cat falls from that height, it lands on all four feet, stands up and walks away without any problems.

Any guesses why cats survive (幸存) while humans don't? It's cats' born ability. While cats fall, they're able to adjust themselves to fall on their feet.

A good example is what a camera filmed: a cat called Sabrina fell from the top of a 32nd building and walked away with only a chipped tooth! For long, people can't understand a cat's ability to fall safely until a cat falling from a great height without any danger of life.

Because cats are so light, the speed is almost equal to the power of air and the two get balanced. As a result, the cat continues to fall but at a balanced speed. In this way, cats can deal with the situation themselves and land on the ground like a parachute.

Unlike humans, cats are able to survive because of a special balance. Thanks to this, the cat's body at once land in a safe way. Even its feet are flexed (弯曲) so that they are able to deal with the shock of the fall. While humans are not so lucky to have the born ability. No wonder that people say "the cat has nine lives all its life".
