The captain of another ship found Mary Celeste floating(漂浮) in the middle of the sea on December 5, 1872. The captain, his family and the sailors were not on the ship and were 48 found.

What happened? Why did they leave the ship? The Mary Celeste was not 49.

South Korea

In South Korea, it is a sign of respect(尊重) for people to bow when greeting each other. In South Korea, a bow is followed by a handshake. However, South Korea women do not shake hands with western men; instead, they bow slightly(轻轻地).

Brazil

Kissing women on the cheek is a common way of greeting. In a formal situation, a handshake is often done to show respect. Men should shake hands before and after meeting, and once they have become familiar with each other, a light hug is often given to each other.

Ghana

In a social situation, it's polite to greet everyone in the room. A handshake is used in greeting, and the palm(手掌) must directly touch the palm of the other. It's considered impolite to touch the back of the hand.

But sometimes the meaning of the sentence will change if the order of words in an English sentence is changed. For example, "She only likes oranges." "Only she likes oranges."

English is a foreign language, which is spoken by people all over the world. When you are learning English, you must do your best to get the spirit of the language and use it as the English speaker does.
