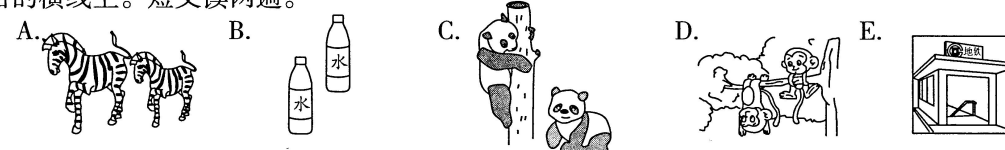

This will also lead to global warming. So if the Amazon rainforest dies, the fight (对抗) against global warming will be more difficult. The worrying snowball effect (效应) will bring lots of trouble to the world.

The Amazon rainforest is home to more than 30,000 types of plants, 2.5 million types of insects, 2,500 types of fish, more than 1,500 types of birds and more than 1,000 types of animals. If the Amazon rainforest dies, they will lose their homes. Then they will be in danger.

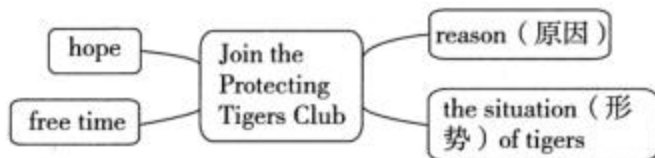
