Odinn Meehan has an unusual illness. He is too sick to go to school but new robot technology — Odinn 2.0 — has allowed him to be back in class.

Odinn, an eight-year-old boy, studies at Rainworth State School in Queensland Australia. He was found to have a disease called juvenile dermatomyositis (幼年型皮炎) or JDM last year. He hasn't been able to go to school since March last year when he started to feel sick. He has had lots of tests, treatments (疗法) and stays in hospital.

Being away from his school and his classmates was getting Odinn down. "Odinn is a happy kid and he loves school," his mother, Romy Willing, said. "For a very social child, he was lonely without his friends." He was learning with the help of the workers at Queensland Children's Hospital when he was receiving treatments, but it wasn't the same.

Luckily, there is MissingSchool, a non profit (非营利的) group. It began 11 years ago, when

three mothers were looking for answers for their own seriously sick children. Since 2017, MissingSchool has been using robots in schools across Australia. They connect seriously sick kids with their normal classroom. It now has more than 180 robots in schools, connecting about 5,400 classmates.

Now Odinn can take classes at home, with Odinn 2.0 in the classroom. The robot has wheels at the bottom, a thin body and a screen as its head. Odinn's happy face is shown on the screen. He controls the robot using his computer. As the robot goes through the space between his classmates' desks, he waves to his friends. It is like he is right there in the classroom.

During the Spring Festival, videos and pictures of Yingge Dance flooded social media. 46 (在...之中) them, one video of Chaoshan youths performing Yingge Dance on the streets became popular online, receiving 47 (千) of views.

Yingge Dance is a type of folk dance with a history of more than three 48 (世纪). It is popular in the Chaoshan area of Guangdong

49 (省). It's said that the traditional dance developed from the Nuo Opera (傩戏) performed



in different parts of China to 50 (欢呼) for the spring, drive away bad things, and wish good luck.

While ancient Nuo Opera tells stories from different folk tales, Yingge Dance is based on the adventures of the great and 51 (勇敢) "108 Heroes" of Liangshan Mountain, best known from the classic novel *The Water Margin*.
