

Almost all of us have watched the movie "Jurassic Park"(侏罗纪公园), but how much do we really know about the creatures(生物) called "dinosaurs"? Here is something you may not know about them.

About sizes



- Dinosaurs have been considered the biggest living things. But in fact, the blue whale(蓝鲸) is bigger than any dinosaur at 108 feet(英尺) (about 33 m). Many people may think dinosaurs were **massive**, but they were usually as small as human or even smaller.
- The smallest dinosaurs that we know of were just 4 feet and weighed less than a chihuahua(吉娃娃).
- A newborn human baby has a bigger brain than most adult dinosaurs had.

About names

- The word "dinosaurs" belongs to the ancient Greek and means "terrible lizard". That's not a nice way to call someone, by the way.
- The fossil of the dinosaur with the longest name was found in China. Its name is: Micropachycephalosaurus.
- Not everything with "saurus" was dinosaurs, like flying pterosaurs weren't dinosaurs at all!





About dinosaur babies

- The smallest dinosaur egg is only 3 centimeters long and weighs 75 grams.
- The largest dinosaur eggs are around 19 inches long.
- Most dinosaurs' eggs are just the size of a basketball.

Others

- Most dinosaurs can be known about by just looking at their bone or tooth.
- The modern relative of T-Rex(霸王龙) is Chicken! We are eating "dinosaurs".
- Some scientists, based on bone evidence(证据), have found out that many dinosaurs lived up to 70-300 years!
- Dinosaurs lived everywhere, even in Antarctica(南极洲).





