Passage 3

Recently, Chinese astronauts, Zhai Zhigang, Wang Yaping and Ye Guangfu, surprised by giving two live science lectures(讲座) from China's Tiangong space station.

In June, 2013, Wang carried out the nation's first space-based class inside an experimental space station module(空间站实验舱)to over 60 million Chinese students. On December 9, 2021, Wang and her teammates delivered(交付) the country's second space lesson, which was the first lecture from the Tiangong space station, showing viewers how they live and work inside the space station. Another live class, held here on March 23, 2022, was Wang's third space class. Here is some information about two of the 4 experiments in this live class.

One experiment showed how to separate oil from water in space. Wang prepared a small bottle of oil and water, which were separated at the beginning, while the students on the ground also had such bottles. They all shook bottles to mix oil and water into a mixture(混合物). The students found their mixture gradually separated into oil and water again, but the one in space did not. When Wang asked for a way to separate water and oil in space, a student from Beijing advised spinning(使……快速旋转)the bottle. Wang's teammate Ye Guangfu tried the way and succeeded in separating the two.

In another experiment, Wang used a toy of Bing Dwen Dwen, the popular mascot(吉祥物) of the Beijing 2022 Winter Olympic Games, to show how objects fly in a weightless environment.

They also had real-time Q & A with the students via video call. Some of the interesting questions are “How do you take care of your skin?”, “Is hot water available?” and “How do tears move through space?”.

Some other cities in the southern part of China, like Chengdu and Guangzhou, are also becoming “thirsty”, The Paper reported. Compared with northern areas, southern areas have more rain and are close to more rivers and lakes. _____ 34 _____

In big cities like Shenzhen and Guangzhou, populations are growing fast. As a result, people and factories need more and more water. _____ 35 _____ It's 1/12 of the country's average(平均水平). According to the United Nations, it is an “absolute water shortage” (极度缺水) when the number is below 500 cubic meters.

_____ 36 _____ For example, most cities in Guangdong depend on the Dongjiang River as their main source(来源) of water. In 2021, the river was reported to be drying up. Because of climate change, there's also less snow in the mountains of Tibet. The snow has long been the source of water for many areas in China. Those mountains might provide less water in the future.

Like Ma, many junior high school students welcomed the changes brought by the policy. Liu Yifei, 14, said she 53 the local museum in Taiyuan, Shanxi, as part of her homework.

“We explored *intangible cultural heritage*(非物质文化遗产), such as colored glaze(琉璃). It's more fun than memorizing(记忆) things from books,” Liu said. Another big 54 for Liu is that she doesn't have tutoring(辅导) classes any more. “This gives me more time to play badminton and gradually(逐渐) get 55 .”

Some students, however, feel anxious about the changes. “I used to take many tutoring classes, but now I've lost their instruction(指导) and need to 56 myself,” said ninth-grader Zhou Xiuwei from Nanjing, Jiangsu. “I felt more stressed this holiday.”

The goal of the double reduction policy is to let students 57 more efficiently(有效地) and develop all-round abilities. “It's challenging for students to be independent and self-directed learners, but this will help them become more creative and find their 58 gifts(天赋),” Wang Jian, director of the education department at Shanghai Normal University, told *Xinmin Weekly*.

Passage 5

In the South China Sea, there is a group of Jiaoren, or Chinese mermaids(美人鱼), whose tears become pearls(珍珠)after they fall. To the north of Kunlun Mountains, there is a monster called Xiangliu, which has nine heads with human faces but the body of a snake. These magic creatures(生物) are from the ancient book of mythical(神话的) legends *Shan Hai Jing*.

Shan Hai Jing, also known as *The Classic of Mountains and Seas*, is said to be at least 2,200 years old. It is about culture and geography of China before the Qin dynasty. It has 31000 words, more or less. The whole collection includes eighteen parts, talking about more than 550 mountains and 300 seas. It also tells many interesting stories and describes lots of mythical creatures.

A famous story in the book is about Zhu Rong, the God of Fire. He is described as having a beast-like(野兽般的) body and a human face, riding around the sky on two dragons. When he had a big fight with Gong Gong, the God of Water, Zhu Rong won. But after the fight, the human world came into complete darkness. Then he brought fire from heaven to the world and taught humans how to use it.

Another famous creature in the book is Feibao, which in another part is named Mo. It is described as a black-and-white monster that feeds on iron(铁). It also goes by "the Iron Eater". The mysterious creature might be the giant panda.

Although it's not clear who wrote it, *Shan Hai Jing* is an important ancient book in the pre Qin period of China and considered one of the treasures of Chinese culture. The stories in the book are now being spread from one generation to another in China. The book has inspired many people like Lu Xun and JK Rowling. There are also many books, films, games and artworks made from it.
