On the evening of March 4th, 2023, the Top Ten People who moved China in 2022 were announced on 2022 Annual People Award Ceremony on CCTV. Deng Xiaolan is one of them. The woman volunteered to teach children music in the mountain village for 18 years.

Deng Xiaolan was born in Yijiazhuang village, Fuping County, Hebei Province in 1943. On Tomb-Sweeping Day(清明节) 2003, she returned to Malan to remember revolutionary(革命的) heroes. On that day, she met a group of primary school students in the village. She asked the

children to sing a song. But they couldn't sing a song at all, not even the national song.

Deng Xiaolan felt a pain about that. She thought childhood without singing is very lonely. After returning to Beijing, she decided to go back to the village and teach music to the children, so that they could become lifelong friends with music. In 2004, after retirement (退休), she came to Malan Village to teach music lessons for the children. Also, she set up the Malan small band, held the Malan Children's Music Festival and built the Moon Stage (舞台).

Deng Xiaolan even took the children to sing in the 2008 Olympic Games. At the opening and closing ceremonies, the children's clear voice echoed (回响) over the Bird's Nest. This group of children from the mountains stood on the stage of the Olympic Games, but it can't separate from teacher Deng more than ten years of hard work.

The great music teacher passed away on March 22, 2022. In the last 18 years of her life, she spent most of her time on music education for children in Malan Village, which brought her happiness and satisfaction. She left herself to a small mountain village, and she put the children in the mountain village on the most beautiful stage. She didn't only move the children, but also the whole China.

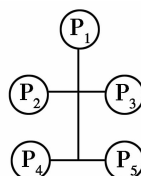

Mars is the fourth planet from the sun. It is home to both the highest mountain and the deepest, longest valley(山谷) in the solar system(太阳系). Olympus Mons, the highest mountain on Mars, is about 27 kilometers high, about three times as tall as Qomolangma. And the deepest valley on Mars reaches as deep as 10 kilometers and runs through east to west for about 4,000 kilometers, about one fifth of the distance around Mars and close to the width of Australia.

Mars is much colder than Earth because it's farther away from the sun. The highest temperature can reach 20℃ while the lowest can be as low as -140℃. Just like Earth, the sun gives Mars seasons. However, the seasons that Mars experiences are more extreme than Earth's. For example, when Mars is farthest from the sun, the southern part of Mars experiences a very long and cold winter, about six months on Earth.

Mars lies farther from the sun than Earth does, so the red planet has a longer year—687 days compared to 365 for our home world. However, the two planets have similar day lengths, 24 hours and 40 minutes for Mars and 24 hours for Earth.

Mars is far from an easy planet to reach but many countries like the USA, Russia, China and Japan are always trying to send people there. Robots have got the tickets to Mars and it's believed that humans will get the tickets by the 2030s, although it is still a big challenge now. And scientists say it will take at least six months for people to travel to Mars.
