The Silk Road is the name of different roads that long ago connected Europe, Africa and Asia. People reached these different places along these roads. Scientists believe people began to travel the Silk Road about 3000 years ago. By the time the Chinese silk trade became important in the world, the Silk Road covered almost 6500 kilometers. It spread from Rome to China, which is from the West to the Far East.

Traders travelling along the Silk Road carried silk, of course. They also carried and traded spices, cloth, valuable stones and gold.

There is a famous old story along the old road. It is said that Roman soldiers traveled through central Asia. They started to live somewhere near the ancient Chinese village of Liqian. Some of these Romans married local Chinese women and the story of blue-eyed villages of China was started.

During its busiest period, the Silk Road allowed people from many different cultures and countries to meet each other and mix. The Silk Road allowed the sharing of valuable goods and new ideas. These included people and trading goods from the Mediterranean, Persian, Magyar, Armenian, Bactrian, Indian and Chinese areas. All these peoples travelled the Silk Road, and they shared goods, stories, languages, and cultures.

In modern times, the old Silk Road routes are still used, but now they are crossed by trains instead of camels and horses. There is even a Silk Route Museum in Jiuquan in China. It has over 35,000 objects from all along the Silk Road. In this way, China protects the history of many countries and peoples.

The digital industry is developing rapidly. There are over seven million jobs in the computer science and technology industries in the United States alone. Yet there is still a gender(性别) gap when it comes to women in technology. These women face many challenges and 41% of them give up trying. So what can be done to close this gender gap?

First, women need to be encouraged to enter the fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM), as well as computer science. It's said that 74% of young women express interest in STEM subjects and computer science. However, women hold only 18% of undergraduate (本科) computer science degrees and 26% of technology jobs. Early education must convey (传递) technology as a tool that can be used to solve problems in real life.

Many young women are put off because they regard the technology as men's job. Women are short of role models. Only 5% of tech leaders are women. They can play a huge role for young women by giving them encouragement, support and guidance. They can also help attract more women to get into the field. However, men working in the tech industry have a duty to listen to women and keep a comfortable work culture as well.

If we go on to empower (授权) women in the tech industry, it will be good for everyone.

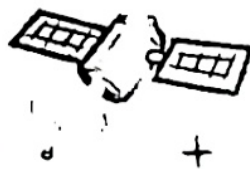

Sometimes you may see news of satellites sent into space. On Feb.21, for example, a US company SpaceX took 46 satellites into space. On Feb.27, China sent 22 satellites into space. Why do we need so many satellites?

At present, there are over 3,000 active satellites moving around the



Earth. Satellites do all kinds of work, from passing TV signals to giving you directions on the road and helping scientists do research.

For example, the 22 satellites China just sent up are part of the BeiDou Navigation(导航) Satellite System. Shared bikes that use BeiDou chips(芯片) can have the more exact positioning. Drones(无人机) can also use BeiDou to fly.

Before satellites, TV signals didn't go very far. Mountains or tall buildings would stop them. Phone calls to faraway places were also a problem. Setting up telephone wires over long distance was difficult. With satellites, TV signals and phone calls can be sent directly to a satellite and back down to different places on Earth. SpaceX's Starlink project is trying to go further. It plans to use satellites to provide the Internet in the future.

Satellites can also provide information about clouds, oceans, land and ice. They help scientists know changes in weather and climate. By checking wildfires and volcanoes, satellites help people deal with natural disasters. Farmers can use satellites to decide the best time to water their fields.

Some satellites fly near other planets. They may look for water on Mars or take close-up pictures of Saturn's rings (土星环).

Cute lion heads, deafening (震耳欲聋的) gongs (锣) and drums, an excited crowd — these are all part of the lion dances you often see during Chinese holidays or at the openings of new shops and restaurants.



Ancient Chinese people 81 (think) the lion stood for braveness and strength. It can drive away evil (邪恶) and bring good luck. As one of the most well-known folk dances in China, 82 lion dance has been performed for more than 2,000 years. It was very popular during the Tang Dynasty (618-907).

Wang Rentao, 41, has been performing the lion dance for 28 years. Born in Zhongkeng village in Dongguan, Guangdong, Wang watched villagers perform it when he was 83 /ʃaŋ/. "It's a time-honored (历史悠久的) tradition here and the love for lion dance is in everyone's blood," Wang said.

Now the head of the village's lion dance troupe (演出队), Wang is 84 (pride) of the group's achievements. "We've 85 (win) many awards and taken part in many important events, including the celebration of the 70th birthday of New China at Tian'anmen Square," Wang said.

Wang's troupe is famous for 86 (dance) on quincunial piles (梅花桩), one of the most difficult lion dance skills. Performers jump from one pile to another at a height of about 2.5 87 (meter). The distance between the piles can be as far as 1.8 meters.

"The training is 88 /'ri:əli/ tough. Performers need to have a solid (扎实的) base of kung fu skills first. Even with that, they can fall from the pile and get hurt," Wang said. "89 that's also the amazing part of lion dance, the part that makes it valuable heritage."

The lion dance is popular not just in China, but in overseas Chinese communities. Many overseas Chinese see the lion as a symbol of China. The lion dance reminds them 90 the culture of their homeland.
